## **HOW TO BECOME A CAMP VOLUNTEER**

1. Complete the online application.
2. Meet with our Camp Coordinator for a virtual interview.
3. A background check and finger printing will be conducted.
4. Attend the volunteer training, watch the half-hour Child Abuse Awareness training video and complete the 25 question quiz.

## VOLUNTEER ROLES

### Group Facilitator

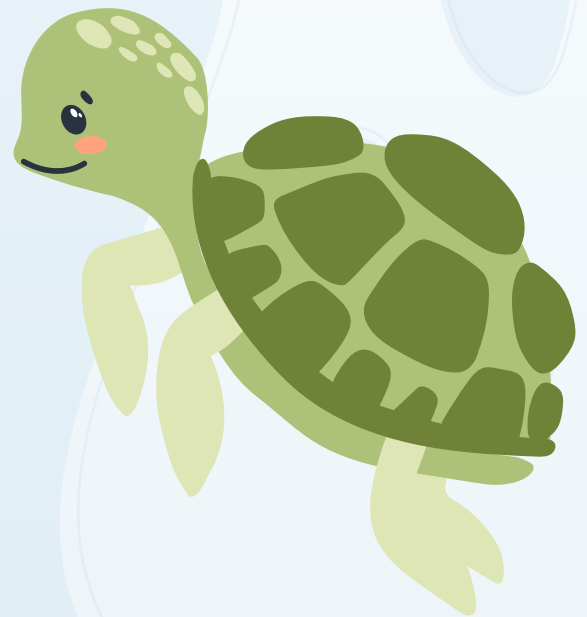
- Co-facilitate group of 8-10 kids for entire camp duration
- Lead campers through daily schedule
- Create safe space by building community amongst campers
- Facilitate conversation and assist with interventions around grief, loved one, coping skills, support system, affirmations, emotions
- Engage in play with campers throughout day and on field trips
- Debrief with large group at the end of each day

### Resource Support Team

- Float as needed to support groups and facilitators
- Accompany and provide individualized support for camper(s) experiencing challenging grief reactions
- Assist in filling coverage needs for groups and facilitators during interventions and field trips

### Service Team

- Assist with daily set up and clean up
- Fill in for group facilitators when support is needed
- Daily registration and check out
- Prepare, pick up, serve, and clean up meals and drinks
- Debrief with large group at the end of each day

# VOLUNTEER ROLES

## **Group Facilitator**

Co-facilitate group of 8-10 children for entire camp duration and create safe space by building cohesion and community amongst group members

## **Service Team**

Assist with daily “behind the scenes” tasks, assist with daily set up and clean up, and is the “Go to” for COH staff to complete tasks

## **Resource Support Team**

Float as needed to support groups and facilitators who may benefit from additional support and accompany and provide individualized support for camper(s) experiencing challenging grief reactions during camp

5. Come to camp!



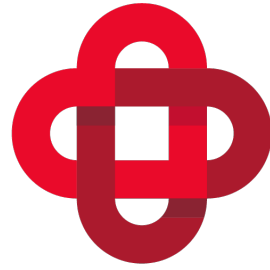
