GOAL 1:

The school site will: As measured by:

Strategy 1.1:

Dahl School will provide individual classrooms with calming corners and a school-wide Wellness Center to support student social-emotional needs

Strategy 1.2:

Dahl School will host spring wellness events to increase an "inclusive, supportive and connected" atmosphere and environment for all students.

Strategy 1.3:

Dahl School will provide families with resources to support student academic and social emotional needs through the use of Coffee with the Principal meetings. Meeting information and resources will be available to 100% of Dahl families via the website, parent square and in the front office. Resources will be available in English, Vietnamese and Spanish.

Strategy 1.4:

All Dahl staff will collaborate and brainstorm culturally-relevant academic, behavioral and social-emotional learning engagement strategies and develop activities for all students to encourage regular attendance and school connectedness

Strategy 1.5:

Dahl School will contract with the Little Heroes program to support safe, structured and fun recess and after school activities for all students grades Transitional Kindergarten through 6th.

Strategy 1.6:

Dahl School will continue to implement Second Step Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) program for TK through 6th grade students to support emotional regulation, situational awareness, and academic achievement.

Strategy 1.7:

Dahl will identify leadership staff to participate in the MTSS cohort 2 training during the 2024-2025 school year. Staff will include teachers, School Social Worker, admin and other identified staff.

Dahl School has focused on student wellness through the implementation of Second Step curriculum, Little Heroes recess program, and staff-wide focus on providing social-emotional learning (SEL) support for students. The Wellness Center was updated in Fall 2022. Each year, our wellness centers continues to get updated materials and expand on the activities presented to support student wellness.

Strategy 2.1:

Dahl Elementary School will partner with AAA Safety Patrol to offer 4th through 6th grade students the opportunity to assist with morning parking lot drop off supervision.

Strategy 2.2:

Dahl School will offer students opportunities to serve on Dahl's Student Leadership Team (SLT) - responsible for supporting community service and developing and promoting spirit activities.

Strategy 2.3:

Dahl Elementary School will implement Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) to design flexible approaches to instruction and learning which will include a system to support student growth mindset and self-efficacy.

Strategy 2.4:

Dahl Elementary staff will implement trauma competent MTSS strategies (as a part of an overall school-wide Multi-Tiered Systems of Support) through on-going professional development workshops, book clubs, and other forms of collaboration.

Strategy 2.5:

Dahl School will offer opportunities for students to feel connected and be contributing members of the Dahl community – (i.e., Little Buddy/Big Buddy program, after school sports, enrichment classes).

Strategy 2.6:

Dahl School will provide anti-bullying workshops for staff, students and families to support a positive school learning climate

Strategy 2.7:

Dahl Elementary School will collaborate with PTA and Cafecitos groups to host family and cultural fun nights and events.


Comments:




