International Fees Schedule

From 1 September 2024 until further notice the fees will be as follows:

Boarding fees

Boarding is available for Year 4 and above. Our boarding fees are inclusive of meals, accommodation, most boarding house activities, laundry, most study materials, compulsory visits for GCSE and A-levels, games and CCF subscription.

Registration and deposit

Parents resident within the UK and EU:

Deposit payable by the parents of each pupil on acceptance of a place £1,500

Parents resident outside the UK and EU

Deposit payable by the parents of each pupil on acceptance of a place £6,000

Administrative Charge

Pupils who require a Child Student Visa £250

The School's Terms and Conditions provide information about deposit refunds.

There is a sibling allowance of 5% for a second child and 10% for any further siblings while all siblings are in Giggleswick School. Once a sibling has left the school then the allowance is no longer applicable.

If you are comfortable meeting the cost of school fees without the sibling discount Giggleswick School asks you to consider donating the discount to the Bursary Fund to help make Giggleswick more affordable for all families.

Please note that a full term's notice is required to withdraw your child from the school.

Extra charges

The following are not included in the fees: fees for external Examination Boards (e.g. GCSE and A-levels), clothing and purchases from the School Shop, certain trips (to theatres etc), a pupil's personal expenses, some optional cocurricular activities, examination fees for speech and drama, and the following optional individual tuition:

1. Speech and drama lessons

Individual 30-minute lessons £255 per term

Shared 30-minute lessons £225 per term

2. Music lessons

Individual 30-minute lessons £35 per lesson

Shared 30-minute lessons £20 per lesson

3. Support (including learning support and EAL)

Individual 30-minute lessons (minimum 10 lessons per term) £365 per term

The number of speech and drama and music lessons given in an academic year are in the region of 30, with a maximum of 33. Lessons are charged in the term they are taken so the charge will fluctuate in line with the length of the term.

Half a term's notice is required to terminate individual speech and drama or music lessons.

4. Exeat stays

If necessary, pupils may stay at school during exeat weekends subject to prior agreement with the School. For any pupil who has to stay at school an additional charge is made.

5. Transport to and from airports

School transport can be provided for pupils to and from the airports at Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds/Bradford, subject to availability and pre-booking. A minimum of 48 hours' notice is required. These journeys are charged at a flat rate per trip, the cost of which is placed on the school bill. There is an additional charge made for any journey to the airport that takes place more than 24 hours before or after the published holiday dates.

7. Lifetime OG Society (OGS) membership - £90

This is charged at the cost of £30 per term for the first three terms of a student's time at Giggleswick and confers lifetime membership of the OG Society for the student and their parents/guardians. Parents/guardians will automatically become members of the global online community when their child joins the school, with access to news, events and networking opportunities. Students will have access to the OGS network throughout their time at school, via activities such as talks, mentoring workshops, 1:1s and other careers activities. Upon leaving the school, students will receive regular updates from the OGS and will be invited to join the online community when they turn 18.

It is the intention of the Governors that there are no changes in fee rates throughout the year. However, Giggleswick School reserves the right to recover additional unforeseen costs, such as those resulting from a change in legislation, and this may be reflected in the fees for future terms.
