Offers class work time daily.

Eligible for High Honors diploma.

POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

Offers class lecture time. Students are responsible for class work independently.

Questions usually answered via email or office hours.

Class with college students or, if online, no physical contact with students to connect with.

Parents cannot communicate on behalf of student and cannot receive communication on behalf of student due to FERPA (unless student signs a release).

Students must be independent, self-motivated, and advocate for themselves when necessary.

Credits from classes will be applied to the student's high school and college transcripts.

Not eligible for High Honors diploma unless course syllabi approved.

Non-weighted grades unless the course is equivalent to our CIS courses.
