My Health My Resources of Tarrant County Overview of MHMR Disability Services

MHMR Disability Services provides services and support for eligible people with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (or IDD) residing in their own homes (including family and foster homes) as well as in alternative living residences and small group homes. Vocational services and supports are provided through job placements in businesses throughout the community and at training and affirmative business sites.

Eligibility for Services

- Must live in Tarrant County
- Must be age 3 years or older (Younger than 3 years should call Early Childhood Intervention, 844-NTX-KIDS)
- Must have a diagnosis of IDD, Autism or pervasive developmental disorder
- Additional program-specific eligibility factors that may include financial eligibility

MHMR is the Local Intellectual and Developmental Disability Authority (LIDDA) for Tarrant County. Information regarding specific eligibility and access to the programs below may be obtained through MHMR of Tarrant County.
