## Thursday, May 30, 2024

**PARADE** 5:00 p.m. Arrive at Marshall Middle School by 4:30 p.m. Cap and Gown must be worn. The parade will begin at the Marshall Middle School and proceed down Green Street to S. Grand, Michigan Avenue, and S. Madison, ending at Marshall Middle School. Seniors will then report to the high school for Commencement. If inclement weather, the parade will be cancelled.

**COMMENCEMENT** 6:00 p.m. Arrive at the high school by 5:45 p.m. Commencement will be held on the athletic field, weather permitting. Cap and gown must be worn.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER** Commencement will be held in the gymnasium. Seating is limited, therefore each senior will be allotted 10 tickets. Tickets will be given to the seniors at check out. Lost tickets will not be replaced. Cap and gown must be worn.

**DRESS CODE** We ask that all seniors wear appropriate graduation attire.

- Marshall High School cap and gown.
- Men, a collared shirt and dress pants.
- Women, a dress or blouse with a skirt or dress pants.
- Footwear must be worn.

The commencement ceremony is a school activity, therefore, all school policies apply. Should a senior report for Commencement under the influence of alcohol or an illegal substance, the individual will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
