SENIOR ACTIVITIES

This packet is designed to assist you in planning for your upcoming senior activities. These activities are specifically for graduating seniors. Please note the events and the details that describe them. If you have any questions, feel free to contact the Activities Office at 661-944-5209 Ext. 387.

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STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

(To Participate in Senior Events Each senior must submit a signed copy of The Senior Contract.)

Seniors must follow all school rules and regulations at all School Activities. Appropriate behavior and regular school attendance are required in order to be eligible for all senior activities. Remember that senior activities, including graduation, are privileges. **School officials reserve the right to remove students from any senior activity, including Grad Night, Prom or Graduation for any of, but not limited to, the following reasons:**

- Any senior who receives disciplinary action within the months prior to graduation may forfeit their participation in the commencement ceremony and/or other senior activities.
- Any senior who has not met all of the graduation requirements 48 hours prior to graduation will not participate in the commencement ceremony.
- Any senior who has not attended the mandatory senior meeting(s) and graduation practices will not participate in the commencement ceremony.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All graduation requirements must be met before the school can certify graduation. **Seniors must meet all graduation requirements in order to participate in the commencement ceremony.**

CAP AND GOWN INFORMATION

All seniors participating in the commencement exercises should have already ordered their cap and gown set. If you have not placed your order, please do so now by contacting Jostens at 818-367-2929 or visit their web www.jostens.com

Purchased cap and gown will be issued during the senior check-out process. *Please iron the wrinkles out of your gown.* Put your cap on well forward with the short point almost between your eyebrows with the top of the cap parallel to the ground. Wear your tassel over your **RIGHT** eye.

The graduation gown, cap, tassel and medallion are yours to keep. Take care of it. Many graduates keep both their cap and gown as important keepsakes. Write your name in your cap. Graduates are not permitted to carry anything, nor may they adorn/decorate their cap and gown.

Everyone should bring several bobby pins and a couple of safety pins for emergencies. It may be very windy, and you will need to secure your caps with bobby pins. If something breaks on your gown, you may need your safety pins. Do not chase your cap or anything else that may blow away. We will have Junior Honor Guards pick up items that are retrievable for you when possible.

SENIOR AWARDS

TIME: 6:00 p.m. (By invitation only)
PLACE: Littlerock High School Theater

The Annual Littlerock High School Senior Awards Night will honor seniors for their scholastic achievements. Scholarships will be presented. This event is by invitation only.

This is a semi-formal event so please dress for success. For example, wear a dress or dress slacks and a blouse or wear slack pants, a dress shirt with collar and tie.

MID-YEAR GRADUATES

Students who graduate at mid-year may go through the graduation exercise at their request in June. Students must go through Senior Check out and attend all 3 days of Graduation Practice. Students MAY NOT participate in school activities other than graduation exercise in June (AR5127) (d).

JUNIOR / SENIOR PROM

Transportation to and from the VENUE will be provided via busses. Students will have to be dropped off and picked up at LHS.

This is a formal dinner-dance event. Please see the Prom form for rules and dress code details.

All students MUST have their school I.D. Approved guests who are non-students must have a current picture I.D. Only guests age 15-20 will be permitted to attend on an approved guest pass. Guest pass applications will be available in the Activities Office, and must be turned in at least 3 days prior to the purchase of the ticket (both LHS student and guest tickets must be purchased together).

GRAD NITE

DATE: TBD
PLACE: Disneyland
Transportation: By school bus (no exceptions)

Information with the dress code will be available in the Grad Nite packet.

TRANSCRIPTS

If you are planning to attend a college, university, or trade school in the fall and they are expecting you to furnish an official transcript after graduation, you will need to order your transcript on-line through your **Naviance Account**. Please see the Counseling office for the instructions to set up an account and order your transcript.

SENIOR CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

- Seniors will complete their check out process from LHS. A checkout schedule will be announced prior to that date.
- **Students must have their school ID in order to check out.**
- Students will proceed through each of the check-out stations in order.
 1. Financial charges: students will check all three lists (library books, textbooks, student charges) for their names.
 2. Library books: students will check in books and fines will be identified
 3. Textbooks: students will check in books and fines will be identified
 4. Student charges: students will pay all charges – CASH or credit/debit ONLY. No Checks.
 5. Graduation Check: students will confirm with a counselor that they have met all graduation requirements and that they do not have substantial discipline that will prevent them from participating in the ceremony.
 6. Cap and gown set: students will pick up their pre-ordered cap and gown
 7. Graduation tickets: students will pick up their allotment of graduation tickets

DIPLOMA PICK UP

Graduates will receive only the cover of their diplomas when they go through the ceremony. Diplomas will be available for pick-up **IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE COMMENCEMENT CEROMONY**, on **IN THE COMMUNITY CENTER**. Please make every effort to pick up your diploma at this time. Otherwise, diplomas are available with the LHS Registrar Monday-Friday, 8 am-12 pm. Diplomas will only be released to the graduate with a picture ID. **DIPLOMAS WILL NOT BE MAILED HOME.**

COMMENCEMENT PRACTICE AND PROCEDURES

Each graduating Senior will receive admission tickets to the commencement ceremony.

Participation in Commencement practice is mandatory. Graduates who do not attend practice will not be allowed to participate in the commencement ceremony. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Please remember, that the Jostens announcements you ordered are **NOT** invitations. There is a difference! With your formal announcements, you are notifying your family and friends of your up-coming graduation. **REMINDER: Graduates must attend all graduation practices!!! All debts to the school must be cleared in order to participate in the ceremony.**

COMMENCEMENT

PLACE: LHS Larry Rucker Field

NOTE: NO Tickets will be sold at the door on the day of graduation.

All graduates MUST BE ON TIME in the large gym by 4:00 pm with their cap, gown, tassel and medallion. This is a semi-formal/dressy casual event. Students should wear dresses or skirts/slacks and blouses, suits, or slacks and jackets with shirts and ties. Purses or bags are not allow and should be left with their parents. Also, students must leave presents, flowers, or other items with parents during graduation. There will be no check-in of valuables and the school will not be responsible for items that may be lost or stolen.

Graduates are not permitted to carry anything, nor may they adorn/decorate their cap and gown.

NOTE: Graduates will be photographed as they receive their diplomas by O'Connor Photography. Proofs will be available online at oconnorphotography.net.

The commencement ceremony is **not** mandatory! It is a **privilege** which comes only once in a person's lifetime!

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

If turned into the Activities Office by November 17, 2023, in order to participate in senior activities

Seniors must follow all school rules and regulations at school and all School Activities. *Appropriate behavior and regular school attendance are required in order to be eligible for school activities.* Remember that activities, including graduation, are privileges. ***School officials reserve the right to remove students from any activity, including prom, Grad Nite or graduation for the following reasons:***

- Any senior who receives disciplinary action in the months prior to graduation may forfeit their participation in the commencement ceremony and/or other senior activities.
- Any senior who has not met all of the graduation requirements 48 hours prior to graduation may not participate in the commencement ceremony.
- Any senior who has not attended the mandatory graduation practices may not participate in the commencement ceremony.
- Any senior who behaves inappropriately during the commencement ceremony may be removed from the ceremony.
