- **All fines & debts must be cleared, and all materials returned (textbooks & devices) before Monday, June 3 at 10:45 am.** No personal checks will be accepted for fines/debts; cash/debit/credit card only. Pay in the Finance Office.
- **EDGENUITY & OFF CAMPUS COURSEWORK:** Friday, May 24 by 3:00pm is the deadline to complete all courses in Edgenuity. If you took any off campus coursework or dual enrollment courses, RBV must receive your official transcripts by Friday, May 31st, 2024.
- **SENIOR SURVEY:** Wednesday, May 29, 2024 is the deadline for seniors to complete the Senior Survey. The survey will be sent to all seniors through their school email and can also be found on the [RBV Counseling Website](#) after it's emailed.
- **FINAL TRANSCRIPTS FOR COLLEGES:** Monday, June 24 is the deadline to request final transcripts to be sent to colleges. Requests must be made via Parchment. [Go to the RBV counseling website](#), click on the "order my transcripts" link and follow the directions. ALL SENIORS going to college MUST request a final transcript to be sent to the college you plan to attend. I. CAP & GOWN DISTRIBUTION: Thursday, May 16, 2024 during lunch & after school until 3:45pm in the Quad

- RBV has a system that provides students with a cap and gown that must be returned after graduation, or students can purchase a cap and gown to keep as a memento from Jostens.
- Students should have already made arrangements to borrow or purchase a cap and gown unit. If seniors have not, they must contact Jostens at 858-486-2020.
- Seniors must show a student ID or driver's license to pick up their caps and gowns.
- Standard cap/gown is maroon with a maroon/silver tassel.
- CSF Life Members* qualify to wear a white cap/gown. Contact Adriana Rieger, adrianarieger@vistausd.org
- IB Diploma Candidates* qualify to wear a silver cap/gown. Contact Melissa Neumann, melissaneumann@vistausd.org.
- Students who qualify to wear approved sashes/cords are limited to wearing up to **three**.
- If you are not able to attend, your cap and gown will be in the front office from 8:00am-4:00pm for you to pick up after May 18th.

II. GRADUATION PRACTICE: Tuesday, June 4, 2024 1:30-2:30 p.m.

- Graduation practice is mandatory!** Students who fail to attend this practice will not be permitted to participate in the ceremony. **No exceptions!**
- Graduates must arrive at the stadium and check in by 1:30 PM sharp. Only graduates are allowed at practice -- friends are not allowed to attend. Parking is in the student parking lot.

III. GRADUATION CEREMONY—SENIOR PROCEDURES: Wednesday, June 5, 2024

- All graduates must bring a picture ID (driver's license or school ID) when they check-in.
- Graduates need to park on the PE lower field/the outfield grass of the Frosh Baseball Field. Entrance is off of Melrose blvd.
- Graduates will enter the 700 wing (follow the signs) between 3:30-4:30p.m. Once seniors are "cleared" and are in a 700 classroom, they cannot leave.
- If graduates are not in line by the beginning of the processional, they will miss the ceremony. Graduates must be in the 700 wing **no later than 4:30 p.m.**

- E. **Graduates are not allowed to bring cameras, cell phones, or video cameras to the ceremony. Graduates should leave their valuables (including wallets, purses, etc.) with parents or locked in their cars;** parents will not be able to hand the students anything until after the ceremony. We have no provision for securing valuables and **are not responsible for lost or stolen items.** Students will be screened for inappropriate and unacceptable items. Any student with these items will be pulled from the line and may not be able to participate in graduation. Sunglasses are permitted.
- F. Students under the influence of drugs/alcohol will be pulled from the ceremony and sent home. Rancho Buena Vista reserves the right to conduct an alcohol breathalyzer test upon entrance to the graduation ceremony.
- G. The main campus will be locked.
- H. Graduates should “dress up” for the graduation ceremony. Students not appropriately dressed will not participate in RBV’s graduation ceremony. All students are encouraged to wear comfortable shoes. Due to the artificial field surface, **high heels are not allowed** (wedges are ok).
- I. Only one flower lei is allowed per graduate. **No money or candy leis are allowed prior or during the ceremony.** Leis need to be worn by students when they arrive at school to check in at the 700 wing.
 - RBV PTSA will be selling flower leis; order information can be found at [PTSA 2024 Graduation Leis](#). Deadline is May 30 to order. These leis will be available for pick up after graduates check in at the 700 wing.

IV. GRADUATION CEREMONY: FAMILY PARKING INFORMATION

- A. **Parking in the student parking lot is limited.** Families may have to park on the streets so they should plan accordingly for time to walk to the stadium. The ceremony starts promptly at 5:00p.m.
- B. **Off campus parking:** Parking in the neighborhoods and shopping centers is at your own risk and you may be towed.
- C. **Disabled parking:** Parking spots will be available for guests with disabilities. Guests are encouraged to arrive early in order to secure a disabled parking spot (limited disabled parking spaces available). The driver will either park in disabled parking (valid CA State permit required) or the driver will drop off the disabled guest at the stadium entrance. V. GRADUATION CEREMONY & FAMILY/GUEST SEATING

- A. The stadium gates will open at 4:00p.m.
- B. There will be two entrance queues into the stadium. One for the home side bleachers, and another for the visitor side bleachers. Crossing between the two sides will not be allowed once your family is inside the stadium. Please line up in your family’s desired entrance location upon arrival to the stadium.
- C. All graduates are guaranteed **10 total guests** to attend the ceremony.
- D. Only guests under two years of age may sit on their parent’s lap and do not require a ticket. Children ages 3 and older are required to use one of the 10 tickets allotted to the graduate.
- E. Entry to the visitor side of the stadium closes at 4:45p.m or when filled to capacity.
- F. Access between the stadium entrance and the visitor stands is closed while graduates are entering the stadium at 5p.m.
- G. During the graduation ceremony, the audience will remain in the bleachers.
- H. When the ceremony has concluded, families will be allowed on the field to meet their graduates. The field will be cleared after 30 minutes.
- I. **Wheelchair Seating:** If you anticipate needing wheelchair seating, please contact Lisa Myers at (760) 727-7284 ext. 72008 or email lisamyers@vistausd.org

- a. The area that is reserved for guests in wheelchairs has limited seating. **All parties seated in the wheelchair seating area are strictly limited to the 10 tickets.**
- b. RBV staff will be available to assist guest(s) to the seating area if needed.
- c. Pre-registered guests with wheelchairs and the 7 other pre-registered guests will enter via the center stadium gate.

VI. GRADUATION PHOTOS/VIDEO/LIVE STREAMING

- A. The graduation ceremony may be live-streamed and can be accessed from the RBV website <https://rbv.vistausd.org/>
- B. Photographs of each student receiving his/her/their diploma will be taken during the ceremony and will be mailed to the graduate from Studio 94.

VII. MISCELLANEOUS GRADUATION REMINDERS FOR PARENTS AND FRIENDS

- A. Food, beverages, balloons, air horns, coolers, or airplane messages are **NOT** allowed in the stadium. Clear sealed water bottles are permitted.
- B. Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the snack bar from PTSA.
- C. By California state law, RBV is an alcohol, smoke and vape-free campus. Drinking alcohol and smoking of any kind is prohibited on campus; this includes the parking lot.
- D. Any guests under the influence of drugs/alcohol will not be allowed into the stadium.
- E. All seniors have earned the right to have their names publicly read and heard by their family and friends. Excessive cheering that drowns out the next student's name from being heard is strongly discouraged.

RBV Graduation 2024 – Frequently Asked Questions

What day is graduation? What time does it start? How long is the graduation ceremony?

Graduation is Wednesday, June 5, 2024, at 5:00p.m. The stadium gates will open at 4:00p.m. Generally, the ceremony lasts about 60 minutes.

What can I bring to graduation? Is it okay to bring bleacher chairs/pads, drinks, or food?

You may bring bleacher chairs/pads and sealed water bottles only. No other food or drink is allowed in the stadium. Food and beverages will be available for purchase at the snack bar from PTSA.

What items are prohibited?

Flyover signs, food, balloons, umbrellas, coolers, horns, and other noise-making gadgets are prohibited.

How do we get a cap and gown for our student to wear at graduation?

RBV has a system that provides students with a cap and gown that must be returned after graduation or students can purchase a cap and gown from Jostens. Contact Jostens, 858-486-2020, if you need to obtain a cap and gown for your student.

We want to buy a cap and gown to keep as a memento. Where can we get these?

Students must wait until Cap and Gown Distribution May 16, when they can buy a cap and gown on site. For more information, contact Jostens (phone: 858-486-2020 or email: Mark.Boyer@jostens.com)

May we order a cap and gown from a company other than Jostens?

No. Jostens is the only company RBV allows at graduation ceremonies.

What if I have a cap and gown from a previous RBV graduate? Can I use that gown?

Yes, but the cap and gown must be approved by the RBV administration. Please bring it to the office before May 16 for approval by the Assistant Principal. Colors are silver for IB Diploma Candidates, white for CSF, and maroon for all other students. You will need to buy a new tassel if you want one with your graduation year.

How many tickets does each student get? Can I get more tickets?

Each graduate is allowed only **10 tickets**. While the school will not issue any additional tickets, students not using all of their tickets may give any extras to their friends.

What kind of decorative wear (leis, hats, and cords) is appropriate for my student?

The class of 2024 is allowed to decorate their graduation cap. In addition, each student may wear only ONE flower lei and up to three RBV approved sashes or cords.

****Please take into consideration the following rules when decorating your graduation cap. Failure to follow these rules will result in the removal of the cap before the ceremony. You will be provided a plain graduation cap to borrow if yours is deemed inappropriate by school administration.**

Graduation cap decoration restrictions:

- Cannot contain any advertisement, symbols, abbreviations, initials, words, slogans, patches, or pictures that refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, or weapons or be of a sexual nature.
- Cannot denote an affiliation with gangs or violence, illegal activity, or disruptive behavior which is detrimental to the safety and welfare of other students or another person.
- Cannot be obscene, profane, vulgar, or lewd.
- Cannot make noise. No bells, horns, or anything that makes noise
- Cannot be three dimensional. Only the flat, top area of the mortar board may be decorated. Additionally, there may be nothing hanging down from any of the sides of the cap.

What is appropriate to put on your cap:

- A note to thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, friend.
- The logo of the university you will be attending after graduation.
- Your graduation year.
- The logo of the branch of the military you will be joining.

Students, we highly suggest you trace your cap onto cardboard and decorate the cardboard. In case you make a mistake you can start over with a new piece of cardboard. We will not furnish new caps if you make a mistake. After you decorate it, stick it to your cap with double-sided tape or Velcro stickers.

*****Administration will reserve the right to disallow anything that is not considered appropriate for our commencement ceremony. *****

What should graduating students wear?

Respectful, but comfortable clothing. Shorts, t-shirts, or flip-flops are not recommended for this ceremony. Additionally, high heels will not be allowed; they will sink into the field.

I have a child under the age of two years old; will he/she need a ticket to get in?

No. Two-years-old and under can sit on a parent/caretaker's lap. Three years of age and older will need a ticket to enter the graduation ceremony.

We have a member of our family in a wheelchair, how will they be seated

If you anticipate needing wheelchair seating, please contact Lisa Myers at 760-727-7284 x72008, or email her at lisamyers@vistausd.org. This will be the only way to access the limited seating area that is reserved for guests in wheelchairs. In order to accommodate those needing assistance, **all parties are strictly limited to the 10 tickets.** RBV staff will be available to assist guest(s) to the seating area if needed. Pre-registered guests with wheelchairs and the 9 other guests, should enter via the center stadium gate.

Will photographs of each student receiving his/her diploma be taken during the ceremony?

Photographs of each student receiving their diploma will be taken during the ceremony and will be mailed to the graduate from Studio 94.
