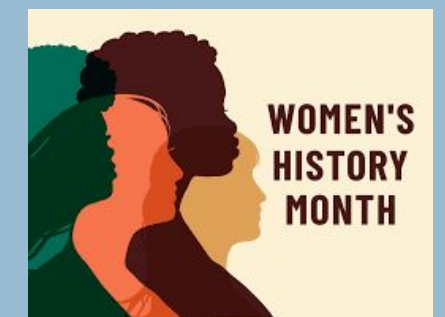
1st Grade Library:
