



FACILITIES condition

Each year, our Maintenance Department conducts a detailed condition assessment for each of our buildings and schools. The detailed report for each school and the building components within each school can be found on our district website.

Our goal is to have every school and sub-system within a school assessed with an Excellent or Good Condition rating. This would mean that each of our schools and buildings would have a rating of at least 90%. Not every school is meeting this goal, and we used these condition assessments to help inform our 2023 Capital Levy Request. Over the next several years, the district will use our current levy proceeds to address existing deficiencies. We will use the updated data to inform future levy and bond proposals for voter consideration.

The overall assessment ratings for each school are:

Anderson Island Multipurpose Building: 94.5 Cherrydale Primary School Main Building: 90.0 Chloe Clark Elementary School Main Building: 87.9 Saltar's Point Elementary School Main Building: 92.5 Pioneer Middle School Main Building: 94.6 Steilacoom High School Main Building: 86.0

Note: Modular buildings do not receive formal condition assessments and are evaluated separately by the Maintenance Department.
