Notes:

- Summer Bridge: Summer camps are a more specific type camp there for it does not have to be considered a Bridge camp. The STEM summer camps available at each campus can have a fee attached to them (\$10). The funds would be used for the students for a sway bag and/or t-shirt. On the flyers/applications make sure to state "scholarship available".
- Bridge STEM Camps: These are meant for incoming freshmen to the STEM program to become familiar with the campus and current STEM teachers/counselors/students. Plan and organize with Student Council sponsors to include the Bridge STEM Camp after the Student Council Fish camp for freshman.
- Healthcare Therapeutics:
  - Pharmacy Tech Program at EPCC
  - St. Phillippe's College Nurse Aide for Healthcare Level 1 16 hrs.
  - WGAM Nurse Science, addendum or separate MOU. Credits for Nurse Practitioner
- FAA Part 107: create a contract for students with following information. This is to ensure quality and effort.
  - Attendance
  - Set up a minimum score on practice exam
  - Set up a minimum GPA in Robotics Class
  - Parents have the option of paying for the exam if the student does not meet criteria mentioned above. If the student passes the exam, the parent will get reimbursement.

Actions

- Due to Covid situation, STEM Summer camps were done virtually and free. The majority of the materials for the camps had to be perishables since students were not in a classroom setting. This limited our budget/student and limited the amount of students per camp (10-14 students). Packets with all camp materials were given to the registered students. Camps took place from June 15 - 18, 2020.

- Conversation is ongoing with the Student Council sponsor to plan Bridge STEM Camp the same day as Fish Camp awaiting the Covid situation in our area.
- ProAction Emergency Services Institute: Emergency Medical Technician Certification; one school year program with a block schedule for seniors only. CTE funding will cover the costs. Program will start in the 2021-22 school year. This will impact % 2022 STEM Senior class.
