Georgia Student Finance Application

In light of the recent challenges associated with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the Georgia Student Finance Application, or GSFApp, is a good alternative for Georgia high school seniors. The GSFApp offers a short application process that is specifically tailored to the requirements of the Zell miller and HOPE Scholarships. It remains valid for ten years and can be done in addition to the FAFSA. Please note that filing the FAFSA is still required for federal aid, loans, and grants.
