Delano High School is a member of the Wright Technical Center (WTC) located in Buffalo. WTC provides advanced career and technical programs to area high school juniors and seniors. Students can explore careers and develop skills useful to them as they complete high school and plan for the future. **A separate Wright Technical Center Program Guide that describes the technical center classes in more detail is available from the counselor.** For information on second year opportunities, earning college credit, and professional certification see the guidance counselor. All classes have a one-year commitment, receive four credits and a letter grade. Classes at WTC begin at 7:55 a.m. (except where noted). A bus to the Wright Technical Center leaves Delano High School at 7:25 a.m. Students must provide their own transportation to the high school to catch the bus. **No students are allowed to drive to the Wright Technical Center for 7:55 a.m. classes.**

There is limited space available in the WTC program. Acceptance into any WTC course may be contingent on attendance record and grade point average. Students need to check their schedules before school starts to make sure they were accepted into the program. Delano High School administration has the authority to remove a student from the Wright Technical Center Program if the student is not making satisfactory academic progress, does not have satisfactory attendance record, or has disciplinary issues.

In the event of inclement weather, students and parents must monitor local news stations for Wright Technical Center ISD #966 and Delano School District for school late starts or school closings. Wright Technical Center DOES NOT follow the Buffalo School District calendar for inclement weather closings. WTC will be listed separately from the Buffalo School District. If Delano has a late start or closes school, there are no WTC classes. If WTC has a late start or closes school and Delano has school on that day, there are no WTC classes, report to your second block class at Delano, or you may come to school for Block 1 and report to the Delano High School Media Center for a study hall.
