



Dear Parents and Guardians,

During school registration for this year, if you stated that your child has Asthma, Seizures, Diabetes, or an Allergy requiring emergency medication, the school is required to have physician orders on file. The WCSD Asthma Action Plan, the Seizure Action Plan, and the WCSD Physician's Order for Diabetes forms must be renewed at the beginning of each school year.

If your child requires a special diet related to an allergy or other health condition, a WCSD Diet Prescription form is needed from your physician. This diet form must be renewed at the beginning of each school year.

If your child requires over-the-counter medications to be given at school, please complete the WCSD Over-the-Counter Medication consent form. This form requires a parent/guardian and a physician's signature. The parent will need to supply any OTC medication in its original container with the label intact along with the completed form.

If your child requires prescription medications to be given daily at school, please complete the appropriate WCSD Prescription Medication Consent form. This form requires a parent/guardian signature.

Forms are available from your school nurse or you may print forms from the Wayne County School District website at <https://www.wcsdms.com/district/medical-forms>. Medication forms are also available. Please provide the appropriate medication form for any medications indicated on the action plans. If it is necessary for your child to keep emergency medication with them at all times, please have your physician fill out the WCSD Release to Carry Form. Otherwise, all medication is kept in the office.

For safety purposes, students are not permitted to transport medication. If you have any questions, please contact your child's school nurse.
