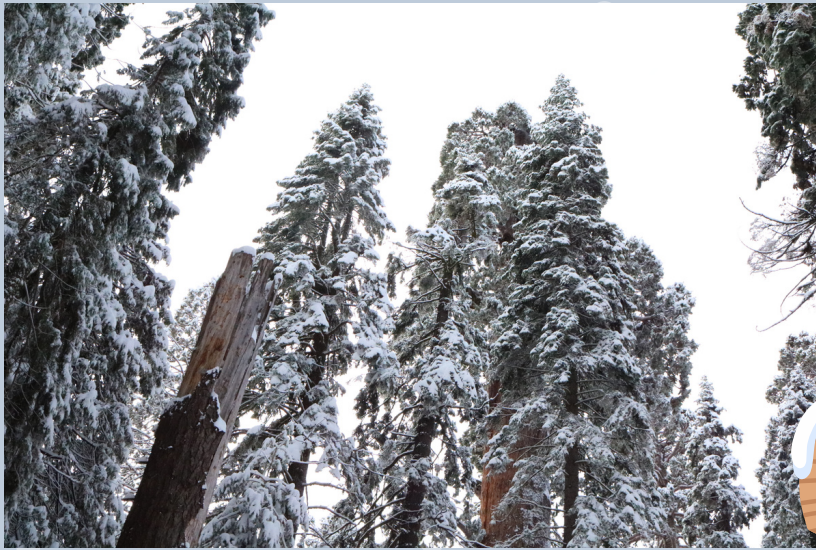

He believes that his problem solving skills are top notch, and it's actually one of his favorite qualities of himself.

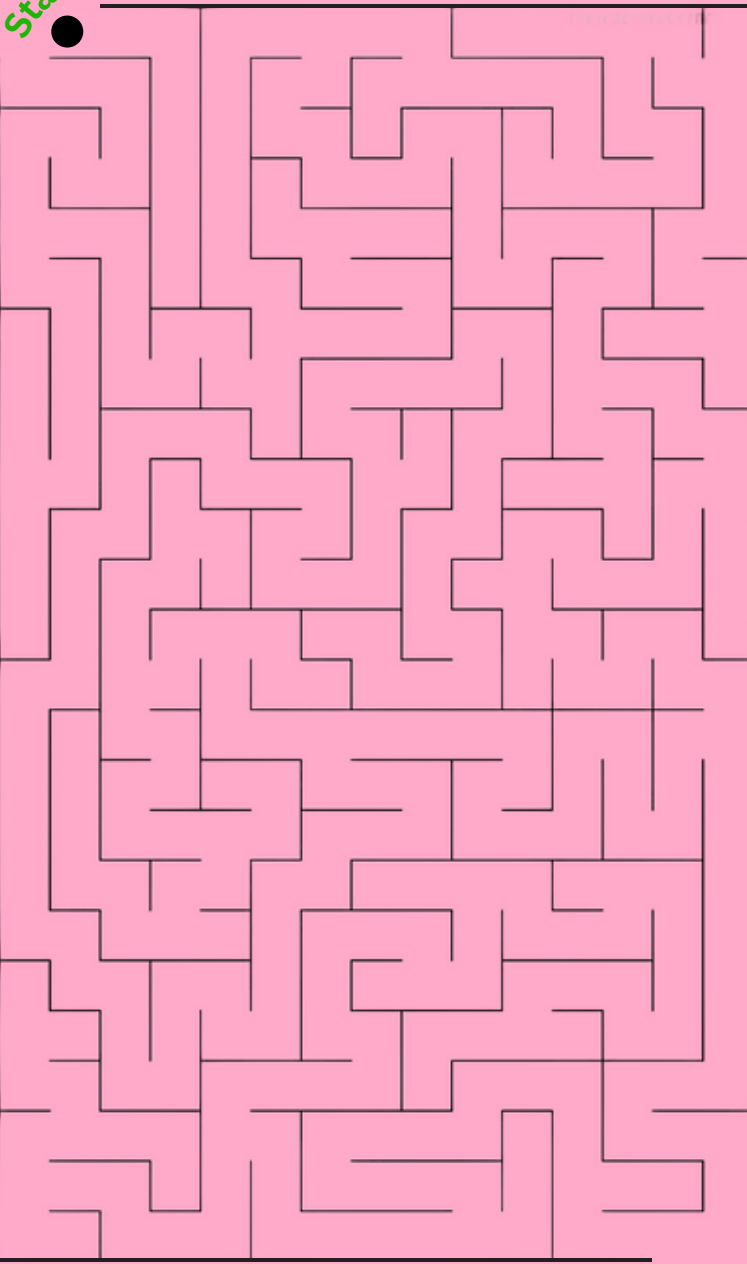
When he puts his mind to completing a task, he doesn't quit until he gets it done or he understands it.

With everything that he's experienced, Mr. Gomez has been able to become a successful, and inspiring figure within his students' lives that's always motivating them to be better.

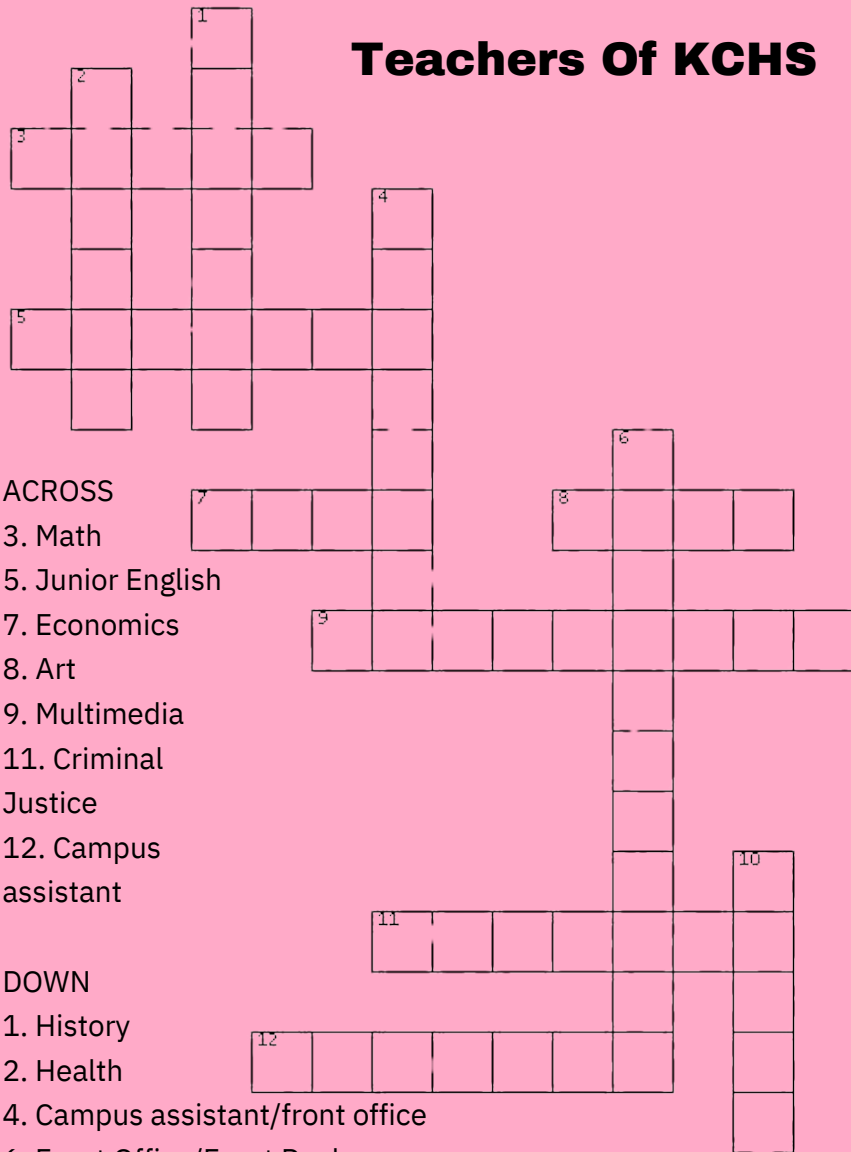
P.S. He stated that if they were to make a movie based on his life, it would be an action or drama.

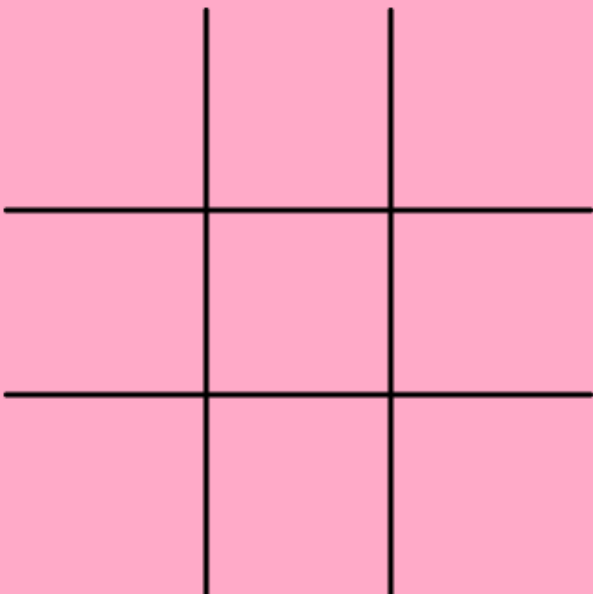
