If you are not satisfied with the Superintendent's decision, you may appeal to the Los Angeles County Office of Education (COE). If you are not satisfied with the COE's decision, you may then appeal to the California Department of Education (CDE). The district's homeless liaison can assist you with this appeal.

## CONTACT INFORMATION:

District Liaison: The district liaison is one of the primary contacts between homeless families and school or district staff. The liaison is responsible for coordinating services to ensure that homeless students enroll in school and have the opportunity to succeed academically, and mediates enrollment disputes as needed.
