- Reports on Meetings/Committees:
 - Mr. Smith and Mrs. Raney continue to attend construction meetings once a week. .
- Review of SPSA for 23-24 School Year:
 - Growth in AA, Hispanic, Students on an IEP, EL students, all shown growth on iReady.
 - We are CSI school (low academically, low attendance, high behavior) which will mean additionally funding to address these areas.
 - Through Needs assessments with all three educational partners, all three partners (students, parents, staff) safety and student behavior was identified as a large need thus the identification of hiring a behaviorist to support those needs for the 23-24 school year.
 - Data shows that more students' behavior modifies with positive consequences than negative consequences
 - 22-23 grant to fund Mission Oaks Park and Rec has expired. We are able to use CSI funds to bring them back
 - After school clubs/activities can be funded through CSI funds
 - Nathan and Janice both stated students are open clubs/activities at lunch and/or after school
 - Question raised by Mrs. Gomaa on how SPSA supports our growing EL student numbers. SPSA has allocated funds for PD, training, curriculum
 - Shannon motioned to approve. Landeros second.
- New Business:
 - 8th grade promotion, June 2nd from 8:30-10:30 am in the large gym. Families invited. 8th graders can leave after and do not have to

attend the last two days of school. Looking into setting up zoom so staff and others can view as well-Mr. Brooks

- Open House May 25th 5-7pm in the green space. Halal food and Leatherby's ice cream available along with swag from our community partners.
 - Camp KJ May 26th which is also a min day. Students will sign up for sessions starting tomorrow. Nathan and Janice enjoyed the water balloon session, skateboarding session
 - Mrs. Rycerz ordering new books through grant she was awarded. \$1500.
 - CAASPP completion rate: Math 97%, CAST 98%, ELA 89% which includes our EL exempted students so once they get sifted out the percentage will go up.
 - 99% of 8th graders leaving for high school with high school plan in Naviance complete
