**Agreement Conditions:** As a condition for my attendance at the Prom, which is to be held on **Saturday, April 27**, at Crafted in San Pedro, CA. I agree to adhere to all regulations as stipulated below, failure to adhere to any of the school rules will result in immediate removal and *no refund will be issued*:

**ATTENDANCE RULES**

- All School rules apply in the Student/Parent Handbook
- Students must be present for school on Friday, April 22, which is the school day before the dance.
- Check in begins at 6:45 pm and dinner will be served at 7:30 pm.
- **Students must arrive by 7:00pm and are not allowed to leave the dance until 10:30pm, no admittance past 8:00 pm**
- A faculty/or administrator will be checking in students and will check all belongings (bags, coats, purses, etc.)
- Students are not allowed to leave the premises/designated area
- Once the student leaves the designated area they will not be permitted back into dance and will face disciplinary action.
- Students not in compliance with dress code will **not be allowed into the dance**
- Students will adhere to School Policy on dancing; Students not in compliance will face disciplinary action
- A parent will be informed if a student is not allowed to enter the dance or if he was asked to leave. *Refunds will not be issued.*

**DRESS CODE**

- Students are to obey the dress code as stated in the Student/Parent Handbook. Students not dressed appropriately for the Formal Event will not be admitted to the dance and will be asked to leave if proper adjustments cannot be made to their attire. *Refunds will not be issued if a student is asked to leave.*
- Clothes should be worn that reflect an attitude of agreement with St. John Bosco's standards:
  - **Females:** Appropriate dress is formal wear, long formal dresses only. A dress that reveals midriff or excessive skin, has slits, or reveals excessive cleavage or has a low back will not be allowed. **Tennis shoes will not be permitted.** Hair with excessive streaks or highlights will not be allowed. Hair not of natural color will not be allowed. Dress questions must be made to Mrs. Fernandez before **April 23, 2024.** *Shoes must be worn on the dance floor at all times; only girls are allowed to switch over to a flat shoe if needed.*
  - **Males:** must wear appropriate formal wear. **Suits with a coat,** dress slacks, a dress shirt and tie, a mandarin collar dress shirt, or turtleneck, and dress shoes are appropriate. **Tennis shoes or casual shoes will not be allowed.** Outrageous hairstyles are prohibited. Facial hair must be well-groomed. One stud earring per ear is permitted.
  - Appropriate dress will be retained throughout the evening. Removal of shoes, ties or untucked shirts will not be allowed. *Shoes must be worn on the dance floor at all times; only girls are allowed to switch over to a flat shoe if needed.*

**GUIDELINES**

Failure to adhere to the regulations listed above will result in automatic expulsion from the event. Should my behavior or that of my guest bring negative attention to St. John Bosco High School, I understand that I am subject to disciplinary measures as stated in the Student/Parent Guide and that I may forfeit my privilege of attending other school functions and perhaps face other disciplinary actions.

If the school suspects a person might be in possession of, or under the influence of illegal substances, he/she must cooperate with due process according to school policy. If deemed necessary by Administration, the student(s) and/or guests will be escorted from the dance, parental contact will be made, law enforcement authorities may be contacted, and students/guests may be subject to further disciplinary action by the school.
