
#### **GRADE 3 ELA RESULTS**




#### **GRADE 4 ELA RESULTS**




#### ANNUAL REGENTS EXAMINATION IN ELA (2022-23)








#### ANNUAL REGENTS EXAMINATION IN LIVING ENVIRONMENT (2022-23)




#### ANNUAL REGENTS EXAMINATION IN PHYSICAL SETTING/EARTH SCIENCE (2022-23)



#### ANNUAL REGENTS EXAMINATION IN PHYSICAL SETTING/CHEMISTRY (2022-23)





## TOTAL COHORT REGENTS EXAMINATION RESULTS

A High School Cohort consists of all students who first enter grade 9 anywhere or, in the case of ungraded students with disabilities, reach their seventeenth birthday in a particular school year (July 1 - June 30). The "year" used to identify the cohort is the year in which the July 1 - December 31 dates fall. Results are reported four years after these students first enter grade 9.

Due to COVID-19 and changes to New York State testing requirements, Regents examinations in June 2020 through January 2022 were canceled, with the exception of the June 2021 Regents Examinations in ELA, Algebra I, Living Environment, and Physical Setting/Earth Science. The U.S. History & Government examination from June 2022 through January 2023 was also canceled.




## 2019 TOTAL COHORT REGENTS IN MATH


## 2019 TOTAL COHORT REGENTS IN SCIENCE

## 2019 TOTAL COHORT REGENTS IN GLOBAL HISTORY & GEOGRAPHY




