The Hesitations are a group from Cleveland, Ohio. They recorded four albums in the 60s which included hits such as *Born Free, Soul Superman, the Impossible Dream, I'm not Built That Way*, and *She Won't Come Back*. But when tragedy struck the group, they disbanded.

In 2006, Art Blakey, the lead singer on most of the hit songs, was asked to put the group back together for a show at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. After having no success with trying to get the original members to join him, he called on some of his friends who were part of a group that he first started singing with as a teenager. The group, *The Sahibs*, was one of Cleveland Ohio's well-respected groups.

After putting a show together and performing for a very responsive crowd, they decided to make a comeback as *The New Hesitations*. Since then they have been playing casinos, country clubs, arenas, and various other venues. They have also been featured on TV and radio shows all over the world. They were asked to come back to The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2009 to be a part of the annual World Festival. And in March of 2010, they performed before thousands of fans in the United Kingdom at the Prestatyn Soul Weekender. The Hesitations were inducted into The R&B Hall of Fame on August 17, 2013 in Cleveland, Ohio.

Their new single *Dance With My Father*, a remake of Luther Vandross' hit, is the first cut from their soon to be released CD.

Members consist of Art Blakey, George Hendricks, Joyce Blakey, William Carter, Vocals; Ronnie Wilson Jr., Drummer; Tim Banks, Guitar; Eric Spearman, Bass; Joe Jenkins Percussions; and Donna Brittain, Keyboards.

Rod McLeod says:


