



NPHS AP Course Enrollment & Exam Data

- ❖ Individual student enrollments in AP courses: **225 individual students enrolled in at least one AP course:**
 - **142** enrolled in only **one** AP course.
 - **44** enrolled in **two** AP courses.
 - **28** enrolled in **three** AP courses.
 - **4** enrolled in **four** AP courses.
 - **2** enrolled in **five** AP courses
- ❖ **72.1%** of AP students took at least one AP exam: **148 total students**
 - **86** took only one AP exam.
 - **42** took two AP exams.
 - **17** took three AP exams.
 - **3** took four AP exams.
- ❖ **64.4%** of eligible AP exams were taken by AP students.
 - Number of AP exams taken by AP students: **225**
 - Number of eligible AP exams: **349**

least one AP course**




Our group scored HIGHER than the State and Global average in both mean score and % scores 3 or higher






Goals in Supporting AP Programming
