

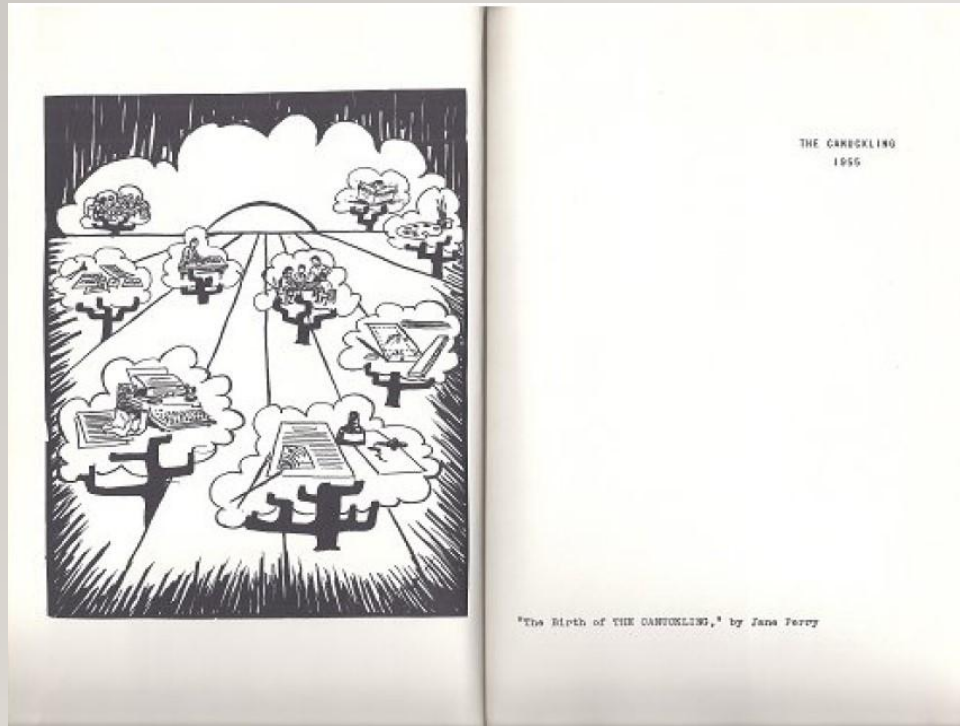

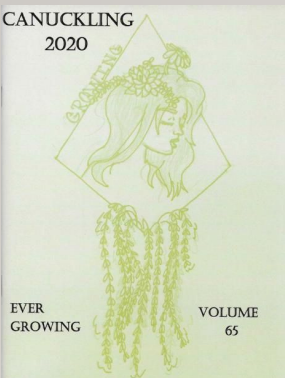
A HISTORY OF AWARD-WINNING ISSUES

- First Place awards from the American Scholastic Press Association.

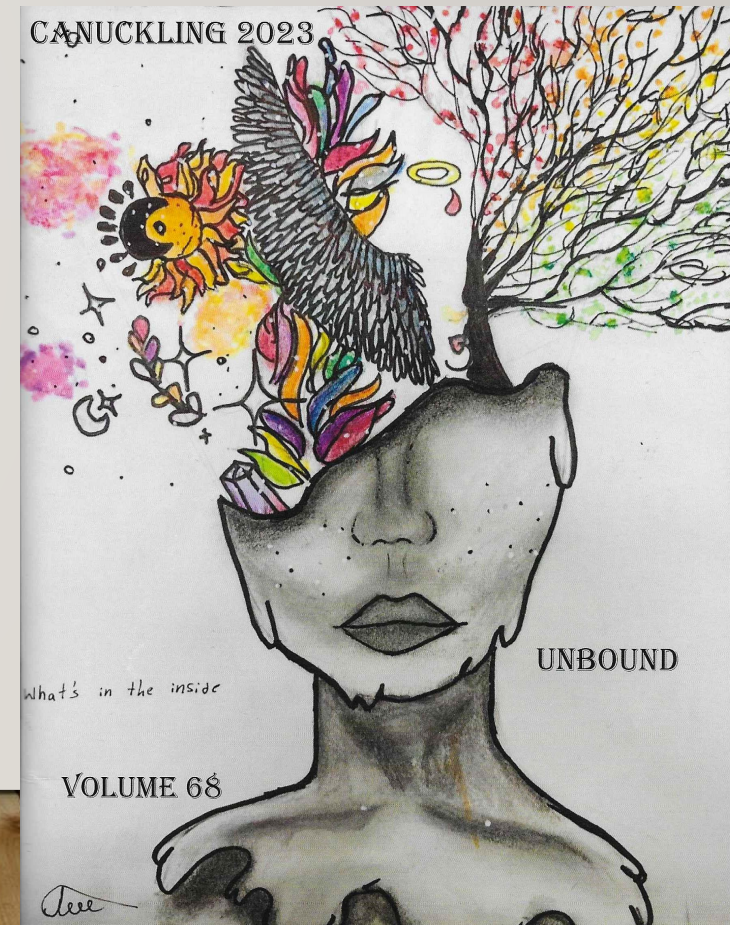
These Press Associations feature judges that critique the quality of the issues of high school literary-art magazines throughout the United States.

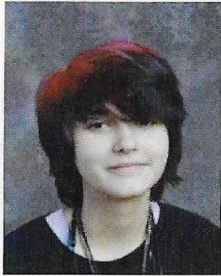


SPECIAL THANKS TO OUR DEDICATED EDITORS & STAFF

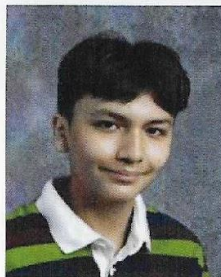

Here is an image of the opening page.



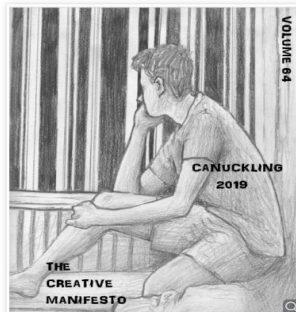
