What is the NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment?

- The NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment is a new test required for all 11th grade students .
- Intended to measure student proficiency in ELA, Algebra and Geometry.
- The first administration of the test occurred in March 2022 for students in the Class of 2023.

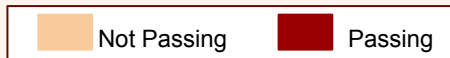
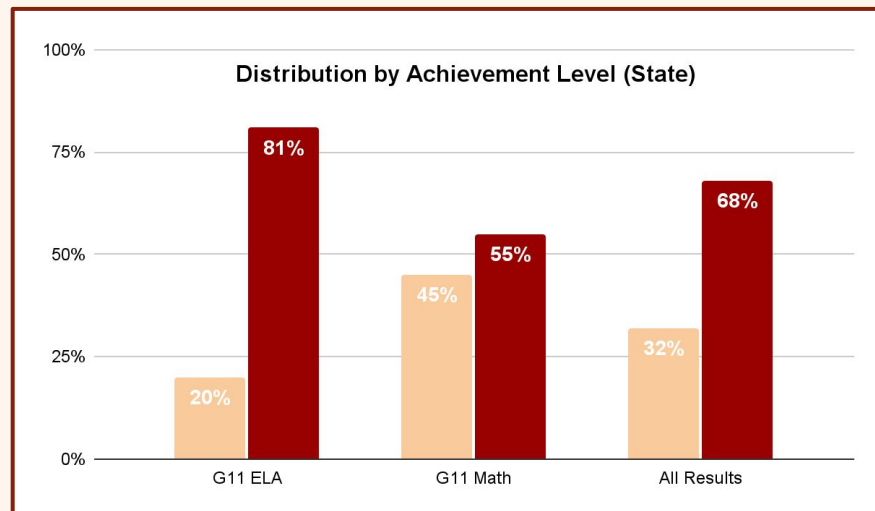
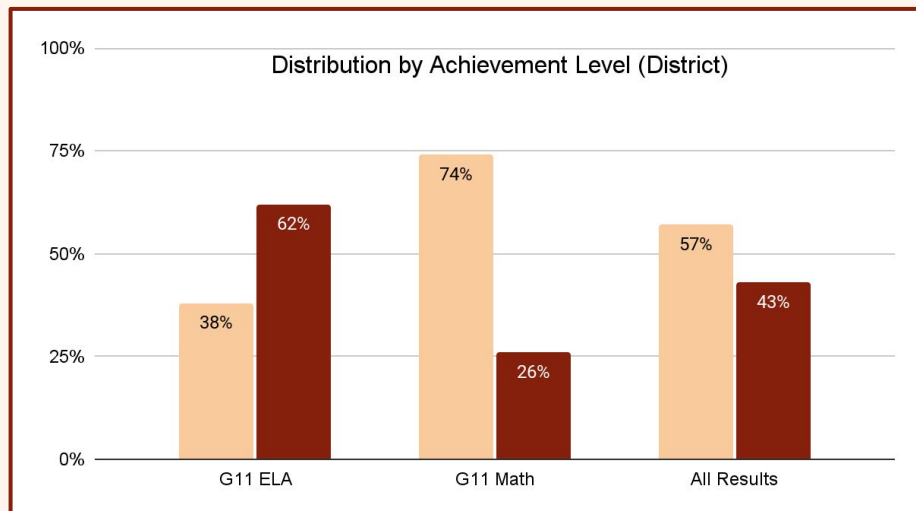
First Pathway - New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA)

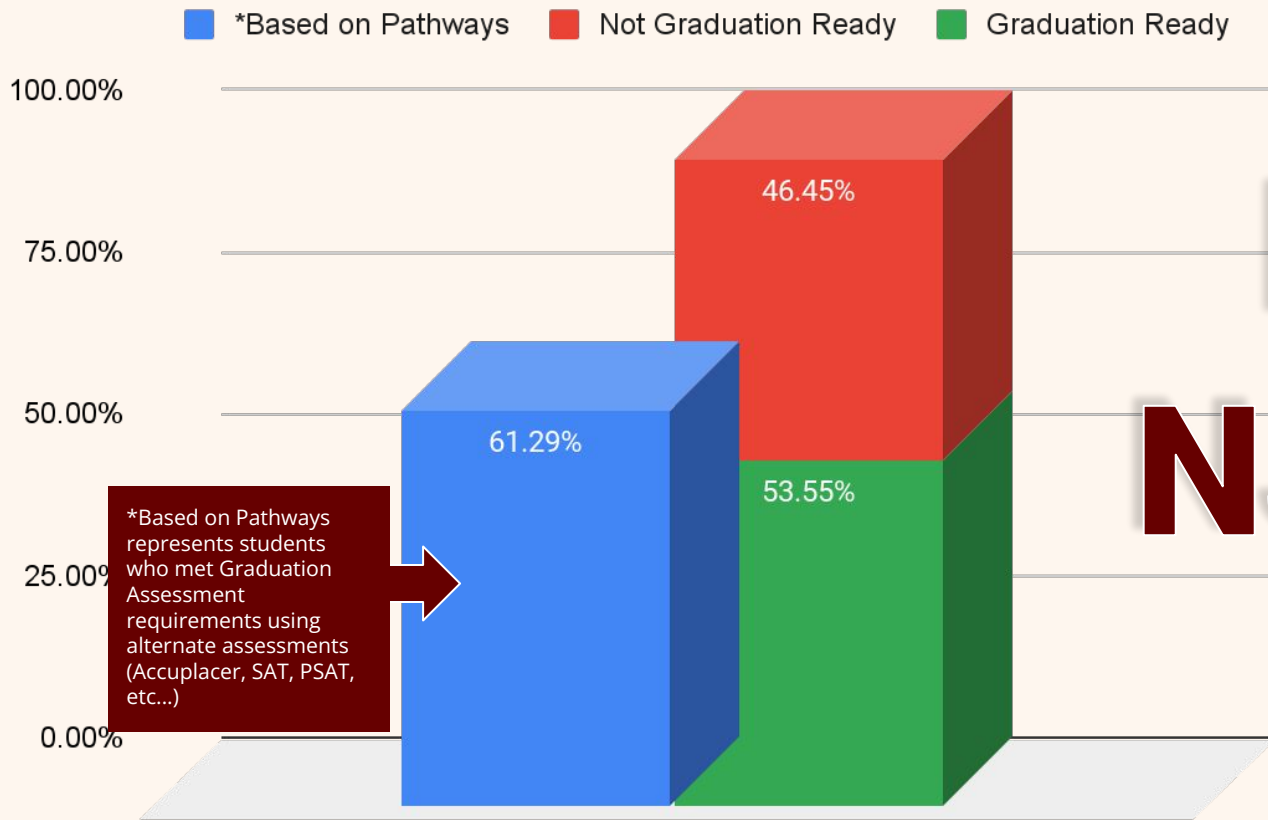

Third Pathway - By submitting, through the district, a student portfolio appeal to the New Jersey Department of Education.

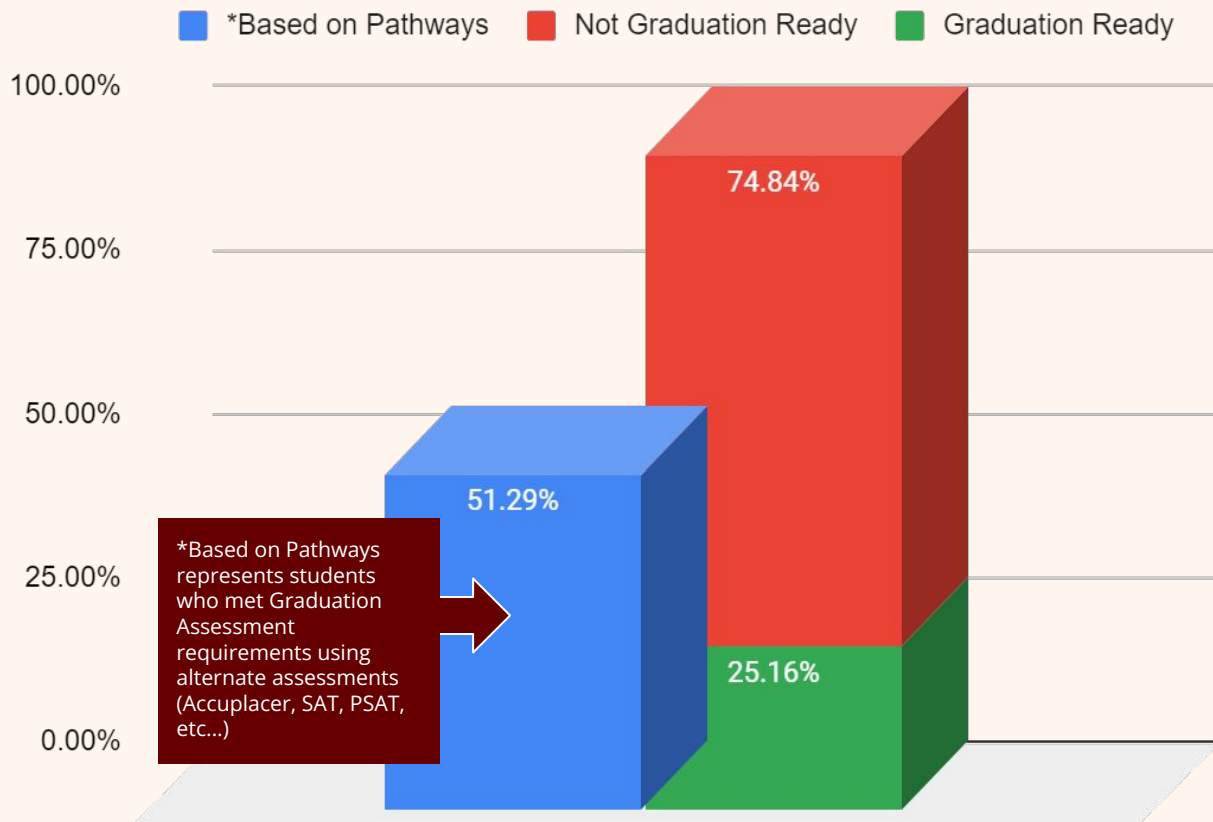
2022-2023 NJGPA



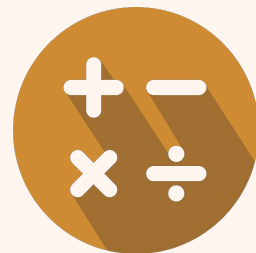


ELA NJGPA

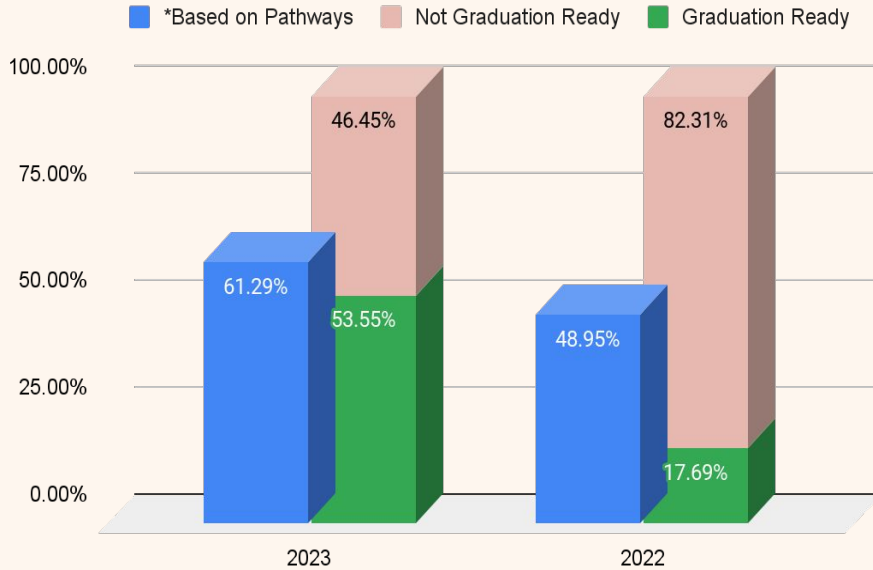




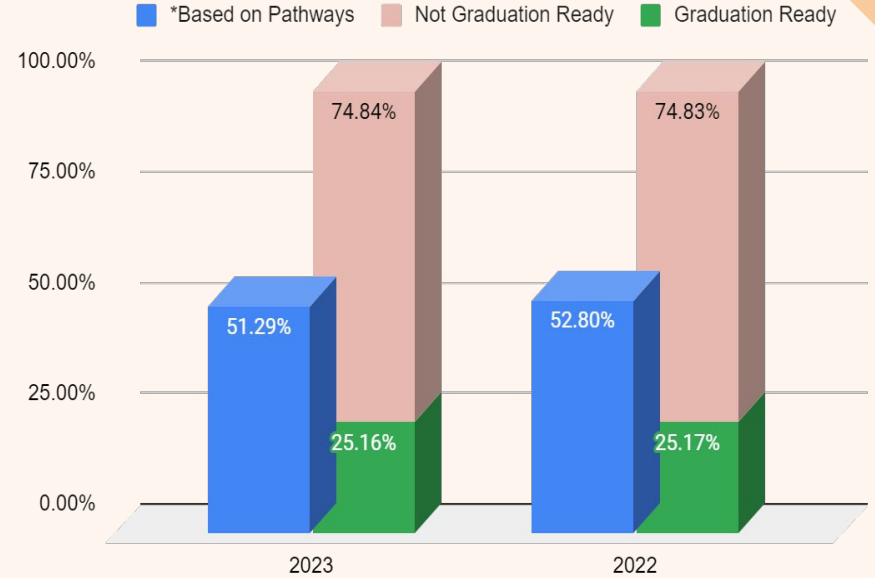
Math NJGPA

- Run Summer Bootcamp
- Schedule lowest scoring students in AS support class
