## What is the NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment?

 The NJ Graduation Proficiency Assessment is a new test required for all 11th grade students.

• Intended to measure student proficiency in ELA, Algebra and Geometry.

 The first administration of the test occurred in March 2022 for students in the Class of 2023.





**Second Pathway** - By meeting the designated cut score on a substitute competency test such as the PSAT, SAT, ACT, or ACCUPLACER; or


**Third Pathway** - By submitting, through the district, a student portfolio appeal to the New Jersey Department of Education.


#### 2022-2023 NJGPA







