

CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

Basic Instructional Program

Instructional programs will be developed with the view toward maintaining a balanced curriculum which will serve the general academic needs of all kindergarten - twelfth grade students and provide opportunities for individual students to develop specific talents and interests (From our policy EHA).

Development and Revision of Curriculum

The Administration shall review, monitor, and develop effective, appropriate curriculum according to any applicable Administrative Regulations. The Six-Year Curriculum Renewal Cycle provides the means for systematic evaluation and modification of the curriculum. The Superintendent shall recommend changes to the curriculum to the Board for Board approval. (Borrowed from *Deer Creek, Putnam City, and Yukon*)

Curriculum Committees: Curriculum committees may be formed in all grades, K-12, and, if formed, shall be composed of teachers, parents or guardians, and administrators. Curriculum committee reports shall reflect current research, best instructional practices, and state-mandated objectives. The Board must approve any changes in curriculum prior to implementing any changes in curriculum as a result of the report of a curriculum committee (Borrowed from: *Putnam City*).

Textbooks and Instructional Materials

The Superintendent shall appoint a textbook committee which shall be organized in accordance with applicable law. Other instructional materials and library materials shall be selected according to Administrative Regulation. (Borrowed from: *Putnam City*)

Course Catalogs

The Administration shall be responsible for preparing a course catalog which sets forth those courses which are to be offered during a particular school year (Borrowed from: *Putnam City*).

Additions or changes in the curriculum will be considered by the board after being recommended through established administrative channels. In all instances, the curriculum will meet the educational requirements established by state law (From our policy EHA).
