Chrome Browser Directions:

- On your computer, open Chrome.
- Go to a webpage written in another language.
- On the right of the address bar, click Translate.
- Click on your preferred language.
- Chrome will translate your current webpage.

Under federal law, [every family has the right](#) to receive information about their child’s education in a language they can understand. The Jefferson City Schools (JCS) Board of Education Office and Federal Programs connects JCS families and staff with translation and interpretation services to ensure all families have the access guaranteed by the U.S. Department of Education. The Federal Programs director coordinates LanguageLine access, provides translation and interpretation services for district-level documents and meetings, and works to support bilingual/multilingual families and staff throughout the district. We also serve as a primary point of contact for Spanish-speaking families needing communication support with their child’s school.

All JCS facilities have 24/7 access to on-demand interpretation in over 80 languages via phone or video through LanguageLine.
