## The Poet's Corner

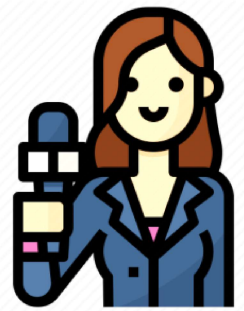

## SPACE

In this newsletter, we will finish our trip through space landing on Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto. We will start on Uranus. Did you know that Uranus is tilted on its side? The length of Uranus is 31,763 miles (about 51117.59 km) and its mass is  $1.914 \times 10^{25}$  lbs.! Next, we will go to Neptune. Did you know that some people believe that it rains diamonds on Neptune? This hypothesis was thought because this planet is made mostly of water, ammonia, and methane and scientists know that it gets hotter and denser the deeper into a planet you go. Scientists also know that methane under increasing pressure breaks molecules apart and releases carbon, which forms long chains that squeeze together to form crystal-like patterns that look like diamonds! Pretty cool? The mass of Neptune is  $2.258 \times 10^{26}$  lbs. and the length of Neptune is 30,775 miles (about 49527.56 km). Finally, we go to Pluto. The mass of Pluto is  $2.88585101 \times 10^{22}$  pounds. The length of Pluto is 1,400 miles (about half the width of the United States). Pluto is found in the Kuiper belt. The Kuiper belt is a large region in the cold, outer reaches of our solar system beyond the orbit of Neptune. Now you know the planets of the solar system.





In the northern hemisphere it is spring now. Spring is the season that begins in March. It only comes around once a year and that's when it starts to get warm! Spring weather is around 69 to 78 degrees in Georgia. The first day of spring this year was March 19, 2024. The weather is getting warmer, so you might not need your big coat and jacket much longer, but maybe you'll still need a hoodie or sweatshirt. It will soon be starting to get hotter so don't dress in your winter clothes. It's time for spring!
