

# TCC Summer Classes

Interested students are allowed to take two courses per summer session at TCC SE campus or online through TCC Connect. Students may take courses located in our [dual credit agreement](#). Courses within our agreement will be tuition free (this does not include TCC plus courses). MISD will provide textbooks for summer courses.

## Summer Session Dates:

Summer 1: May 28th - June 27th (Last day to drop class is June 20th.)

Summer 2: July 1st- July 31st (Last day to drop class is July 24th.)

Please note that TCC summer classes do not receive the same level of campus support as classes during the school year since they are not held in MISD. Students needing assistance should reach out to their professor for help or TCC if their professor cannot assist. Students electing to drop a class should do so in My TCC Track.

## Important Registration Dates:

March 11th Summer schedule is visible in My TCC Track

March 25th Summer registration opens

May 23rd TCC Deadline for Summer 1 registration.

June 27th TCC Deadline for Summer 2 registration.

**Priority Deadline for both sessions May 1st for MISD**

## Registration Process

- Eligible students must complete [google form](#) so counselor knows you are interested in summer class.
- See [dual credit canvas course](#) for steps required to take dual credit courses.
- Students register on their own (students taking face to face classes will need to get meningitis shot and submit to TCC)
- If this is your first class, please complete new student orientation.
- Current students may be required to visit with TCC advisor if you have 15 or more hours.

## Textbooks

There will be scheduled dates in May for students to pick up the required textbooks. Information will be communicated once books arrive. **Please register by the May 1st deadline to be sure your book is in before class begins.** Students who wait until the TCC deadline may not have their books the first day of class.

## Grades

As a district, we will get a report in August of MISD students who took a dual credit class. If a numeric grade is provided (sometimes we only get a letter grade) we will use the numeric grade. If only a letter grade is provided, grades will be converted according to the scale located in the MISD [course guide](#). Students should submit a screenshot of their final TCC Canvas grade along with their official TCC transcript. If there is a grade discrepancy between the screenshot and the numeric grade on the provided report, the grade on the report will be the one used. **This must be submitted no later than the 1st day of school.**
