*Childcare in the community- Blue Ribbon report was put out and it is all tied to funding. There is a push from OEC for more infant and toddler support/opportunities. They are also considering changing the adult to child ratio from 1:4 to 1:5, to allow for more children to access service.

*SR updates-Monies will be sent directly to programs receiving SR funding as long as the grant holding agent meets the level of audit compliance. Short version application year, no RFP's.

*Enrollment – TLC is full, FRC is full until March 1. It was reported that we have 20 students within the district that do not have permanent housing.

*K transition updates-Literacy Night was attended by 30 children. All programs had representation. Books and program information were handed out. We had less grant funding for these events. May will be the next literacy night, held at PCS outdoors, Math and Motor.
