Process art is a form of art where the joy is in the process, not necessarily in the finished piece. Finding a few paper squares glued onto a white paper doesn't exactly fill the viewer with awe, but the child who enjoyed picking up the little pieces of paper one at a time and placing them in a spot of glue was excited about all of the skills that were used to make such a work of art. Texture adds an element of interest as there is a sensory component to the art work, and after it is crumpled, pulled apart and sticking to their fingers, the portion that makes it onto the material for which it was intended has the same appeal as a touch and feel book. Color also adds an important visual element, whether using only one color or using multiple colors. Multiple colors, such as in the case of paint, often result in an olive green or a brown hue due to the mixing of the colors, but the children enjoy dabbing their brushes into each color or several colors in a row before painting on the paper, sometimes stating the name of the color as they dab. Process art allows you to see the beauty of the children using their skills and abilities to create, and therein lies the beauty of the piece of art.

Our themes for April are: Spring, Flowers, Baby Animals, and New Life.

May the spring bring family time that will soon be cherished memories, and may God bless your families.
