

## **Graduation will be Friday, May 24th at 6:30 pm at the Albany Civic Center**

### **Graduation Dress Code**

- All graduates will wear the official Lee County High School cap and gown provided by Jostens.
- Hanging the gown on a clothes hanger several days prior to graduation will eliminate wrinkles.
- The gown should not be ironed – it will melt.
- Administrators will make sure each senior's attire is appropriate.
- HATS - should not be decorated.

### **Graduation Practice**

- Friday, May 24th at 9 am at the Civic Center
- Come to graduation practice in the clothes you plan to wear at graduation.
- Do not wear your cap and gown.

### **Dress for graduates:**

- Solid-colored dress and solid-colored shoes (no tennis shoes, slides, boots, or flip-flops).  
Caution: high heels catch and you may fall)

OR

- Dress pants or khakis (no jeans), white shirt, dark solid tie, socks, and solid colored shoes (no flip flops or slides).

### **Honor Cords, stoles and medals**

- Only school-approved honor cords, stoles, or medals may be worn during the ceremony. NATIONAL SOCIETY OF HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARS is not a school-approved organization.
- No other accessories are allowed.
- No stoles or cords may be worn over the gown at graduation unless they have been approved by the Regalia Committee.
- Pre-approved regalia are listed below:

Black stole with gold patch denotes AP Capstone Diploma recipient

Silver cord denotes AP Seminar and Research Certificate recipient

Gold cord and tassel denotes LCHS Honor graduates

Gold medal with blue ribbon denotes National Honor Society

Red stole with SHS patch denotes Spanish Honor Society

Blue stole denotes International Thespian Society

Gold stole with patch denotes Beta Club

Purple cord denotes National Technical Honor Society

Royal blue and gold cords denotes Quill and Scroll International Honor Society

Silver and Burgundy cord denotes National Forensic League

Black cord denotes Pathway National Credential Recipient

Black, royal blue, and silver cord with black tassel denotes Governor's Honors Program Alumni

Red, white, and blue cord denotes Georgia Student Service Award
