## SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

### **DRIVER EDUCATION (Classroom Portion) (8:00 to 10:00) 6/3/24—6/28/24**

Driver Education classroom introduces students to Illinois Rules of the Road, vehicle control procedures, risk management techniques, skills that assist drivers in different environments and decision making methods to become responsible drivers. Students will apply for permits during the classroom portion of driver education. Students are required to have passed 8 courses in the previous two semesters, must turn 15 before or during this four week course, show proof of age: certified birth certificate or military ID, pay a \$20 fee to the Illinois Secretary of State's Office, pass a written test and pass a vision test 20/40. Note, a student must have a minimum of 30 hours of classroom seat time to pass the course. Students will be scheduled for twelve (12) hours of behind-the-wheel instruction which may occur concurrently with classroom driver education or after the classroom portion. Behind the wheel driving lessons must be driven in no less than a 6 week period of time. (4 weeks allowable in the summer). The course will be offered in the opposite time slot of Technology Essentials. (¼ credit)

### **TECHNOLOGY ESSENTIALS (10:15 to 12:15) 6/3/24—6/28/24**

This course is designed to develop and enhance the abilities to key by touch, proofread, correct errors, and format a variety of documents used throughout the OTHS curriculum. Students enrolled in Technology Essentials will obtain necessary skills related to the daily use of technology in education. They will learn to properly utilize the OTHS student data drive, develop important file management skills, format documents in Microsoft Word including announcements, letters, and MLA reports, utilizing a variety of Word 2019 features and shortcuts. Students will also gain experience with their OTHS Cloud email accounts and learn email etiquette while developing the ability to organize work and meet deadlines. Fees for this course will be waived if taken in conjunction with Driver Education. The course will be offered in the opposite time slot of Driver Education. (¼ credit)

### **CO-ED PHYSICAL EDUCATION (8:00 to 12:15) 6/3/24—6/28/24**

As an outgrowth of physical well-being, all activities in life are determined. Our aims are compatible to those of general education, providing experience through a variety of physical activities that places students in situations, which offer physical, mental, social and emotional involvement. This co-ed course will primarily emphasize leisure time activities possibly including tennis, golf, bowling, weight training, recreational activities, team sports, and swimming. (Open to incoming 9, 10, 11 and 12 grade students.) (½ credit)

### **OTHS PACE CREDIT RECOVERY— (10:15 to 12:15) (12:30 to 2:30) 6/3/24—6/28/24**

Students that have completed at least two semesters of coursework, have failed courses, and are in need of earning credit, can take part in the OTHS Credit Recovery program. Two sessions are held on the Smiley Campus; students may enroll in only one session. This program has limited enrollment and students must be recommended by their School Counselor. For more information, contact your School Counselor in the Guidance Office. OTHS Credit Recovery is tuition based. The fee per course is \$75.

### **ONLINE LEARNING COURSES— ILLINOIS VIRTUAL SCHOOLS AND ACADEMY (6/4/24—8/2/24)**

Students who desire to take courses not offered at OTHS, to enrich content knowledge, to retake credits, or as an alternative to complete coursework, can explore this option. This opportunity is offered through Illinois Virtual Schools & Academy. Enrollment in IVSA coursework is tuition based with specific enrollment start and end dates.
