



CHEMICAL HAZARD PROGRAM

The Mead School District recognizes that the chemical hazard program is an integral part of the District's safety program. Employees will be provided with information and training on hazardous chemicals used in their work place pursuant to WAC 296-800-170.

The District Safety Officer is responsible for the collection, distribution and maintenance of the Safety Data Sheets (SDS), related information, and training records. A SDS binder and written program procedures will be maintained in the office of each work site. Work site supervisors are responsible for the ongoing assurance of training new employees, disseminating information, and requesting SDS forms for new products.
