





WEEKLY RECAPS:


Volleyball:

Cross Country:

Aprende Cross Country, Wow... Wow ... Wow the work our student athletes (our "EXPRESS TEAM") put in this season showed up in the Conference Championship meet on Saturday. Our team did AMAZING! The varsity girls team kicked off the meet capturing 2nd place overall. The varsity team was led by a host of 6th graders (our bright future), Lucia Valenzuela-Ezrre has been Aprende's #1 runner all season long and received a 5th place medal, another 6th grader, Zoe Anspach, stepped up receiving the 7th place medal, the only 8th grader, Zoe Ontiveros, medaled 9th, 6th grader Taliya Drake received a 15th medal, Ryan Kim, 7th grader, filling in at the last minute getting the 16th medal and helping the team score 47 points, 6th grader, Aliya Drake, received the 20th medal and the final runner was 7th grader Liv Bokatius who helped the team to a 2nd place plaque.

The varsity boys finished in 3rd place with 56 points to KMS 2nd place 54 points, and Altadena 1st 54 points (tie broke by 6th runner).
