
Traffic Flow Pattern

Below is a map showing the traffic flow pattern for entering & exiting parking lots for student drop off & pick up at Aprende & Brisas. There are "Do Not Enter Signs" on the Exits to each of our parking lot driveways. Please do not use the North Staff Parking Lot during drop off and pick up times. This parking lot is for staff and buses only during those times. Please review the map - it shows where to drop off and pick up depending on the direction you enter our school zone. Also, there should be no dropping your student off when you are stopped in middle of the road. This is a huge safety concern. We also prefer that you utilize the drop off system instead of parking on the street or at Desert Breeze Park to drop your child off at school as this causes more traffic issues and interrupts the way the flow of traffic is supposed to work.

If you travel from Ray Road you will turn left into the shared parking lot in front of Brisas/Aprende offices to drop off & pick up, exit right back towards Ray Road. Once you pull into the parking lot and come to a stopping point in the drop off line, your child should immediately exit the vehicle onto the sidewalk and enter the school. This allows you to be ready to move and exit the parking lot when the line moves again. Please stay in the drop off line and wait for the line to move to exit.

If you travel from McClintock you will turn right into the parking lot in front of Brisas' Field (playground/preschool), pull all the way forward, and your child will exit onto the sidewalk and walk in front of Brisas to Aprende. You will exit this parking lot by turning left and return in the direction of McClintock. Thank you.

Also, for the safety of everyone, we need every student and parent that walks across Desert Breeze Blvd to use one of our cross walks. We have a cross walk at the stop sign at Desert Breeze Blvd and Joshua and another cross walk in front of the Brisas parking lot. We ask that everyone do their part keeping the students safe as they make their way to and from school. No Jaywalking or U-Turns Allowed! Thank you for putting safety first!



Corona - ASU Engineering Information Session Follow Up







Before & After School Enrollment Changes

Dear Kyrene Families,

Planning for the 2024-25 school year is already underway, and we want to make you aware of changes to enrollment for Community Education programs, including Kids Club, After Hours, and Community and Signature Preschool. Beginning this year, all Community Education programming will open registration on the same day that general enrollment begins. Mark your calendar for January 9!

Another change this year will ensure all Kyrene families have an equal opportunity to register for before and after school programming, which can fill up quickly. In fairness to families who have been waitlisted in past years, there will be no pre-registration option for currently enrolled students this year. Registration for Kids Club and After Hours for the 2024-25 school year will open for all students on January 9 at 6:30 a.m. in the <u>Community Ed registration portal</u>. We strongly encourage interested families to be online promptly at 6:30 a.m. to begin registration.

Families enrolling students in Community or Signature Preschool programs will also register through the Community Ed registration portal on January 9. If you are registering a child for Integrated Preschool or looking to change Kyrene schools, that can be done through the Kyrene general enrollment portal.

Open enrollment information Preschool information Community Education information Remember: whether you are planning to change your child's school, register a new preschool or kindergarten student, or secure a spot in a before or after school program for the 2024-25 school year, enrollment day is January 9!

Summer 2024 program registration will open March 4, 2024.
