

CAREERS EDUCATION POETRY

Christmas Term

- **September:** Introductory PSCHE careers assembly presentation on the careers programme for the year. Pupils complete the UCAS Careers Quiz which aligns personal values, interests, strengths, and skills with suitable university courses/careers.
- October: Oxbridge, Medsoc, Lawsoc and Apprenticeships meetings commence for those interested in pursuing medicine/veterinary/dentistry, law or an apprenticeship.
- **November**: PSCHE Careers assemblies continue and address the next step options available, including higher education, further training, apprenticeships and gap year opportunities guest speakers.
- **September to December ongoing:** Regular inhouse lunchtime information sessions on applying to international universities including USA & Canada, European countries, Asia and Australia and New Zealand. Regular inhouse lunchtime information sessions on different jobs across a variety of career sectors.

Easter Term

January- April ongoing:

- Monthly PSCHE careers assemblies continue (UCAS explanations, a Rhetorician's view, researching universities, application process) on the next step options available. Oxbridge, Medsoc, Lawsoc and Apprenticeship meetings continue.
- Individual career-focused meetings with Careers staff and tutors.
- Inhouse lunchtime career sessions continue on applying to international universities including USA & Canada, European countries, Asia and Australia and New Zealand.
- March: Whole year group visit Lancaster university (Full-day trip off timetable). Poetry parents' weekend: careers education presentation and parent career consultations.

Summer Term

- June: UniFest day (off timetable) for university application preparation which includes UCAS Apply registration workshops and a presentation on UCAS personal statements from external and internal speakers.
- May-July ongoing: individual meetings with Poets to discuss future plans.
