



#### THE COMMON APPLICATION

- 1 Application for over 1000 College/Universities
- Transcripts are Uploaded by Counseling Staff
- Letters of Recommendation are Requested & Uploaded
- Deadlines, Requirements, & Status Updates
  - Early Decision
  - Early Action
  - Regular Decision
  - Rolling Admission
  - Deferment
  - Denial



#### LETTERS OF REC & ESSAYS

# RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

- Not always required
- 1 counselor, 1 teacher, 1 personal
- Utilize Senior Info Sheet
  - Quality over Quantity
- Request *at least* 2 weeks in advance

#### **ESSAYS**

- Not always required
- If optional, write it!
- Be specific, but be honest
- Have English teacher proof drafts
- Save essays for scholarships

# COMMON APPLICATION 2024-2025 ESSAY PROMPTS

- 1. Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.
- 2. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
- 3. Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?
- 4. Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?
- 5. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
- 6. Describe a topic, idea, or concept you find so engaging that it makes you lose all track of time. Why does it captivate you? What or who do you turn to when you want to learn more?
- 7. Share an essay on any topic of your choice. It can be one you've already written, one that responds to a different prompt, or one of your own design.

# COMMON APPLICATION FAQS

#### When should I create my Common App?

- Common App opens August 1st every year
- You can create an account and save answers to Common App tab questions at any time
- Responses to questions in your My Colleges tab do not remain year over year and should only be started if you intend to apply this school year

# Can schools see to which other colleges I've applied?

- Your application data is private and will not be shared with other colleges

# If I make a mistake, can I delete or start a new Common App account?


- You may delete your account, but deleting your account is permanent and will delete *all* application data
- Before deleting your account, contact Common App for help to common problems

#### Which email address should I use?

- Use a personal email address that you check regularly and will have access to after you graduate


# REQUESTING TRANSCRIPTS

- Seniors may request an official transcript online through Scribbles on the GHS Counseling Website.
- Transcripts may be sent directly to colleges and universities, scholarship organizations, or to the student directly.
- For colleges and universities not linked to the Scribbles network, students will be asked to provide a stamped envelope so that the transcript may be mailed.
- Fall '24Transcripts will have GPA/Rank through end of 11th Grade AND Senior Classes around Mid-September of 2024






