Elementary School - Bullying

- Lessons are taught in every classroom in October as well as follow-up lessons in February. Teachers discuss bullying policy in a "kid friendly way"
- STOP - WALK - TALK
 - K - What is a bully? - we discuss the difference between a bully and a friend.
 - 1st - How can you stand up for yourself and others who might be bullied.
 - 2nd - Types of bullies
 - 3rd - Different strategies for how to stop a bully
 - 4th - Types of conflict

Middle School - Bullying

- National Bullying Prevention Month during October
- Anti-bullying lesson that is presented to all students (counselors)
- Celebrating National Unity Day by wearing orange
- Making announcements over the intercom here and there
- Teachers tie anti-bullying messages into their curriculum when appropriate (e.g. ELA teachers will choose some writing prompts)

Junior High - Bullying

- This is more one on one conversations to walk students through their scenario and how to better put themselves in better situations

- 1:1 Conversations (counselors, social workers, admin)
