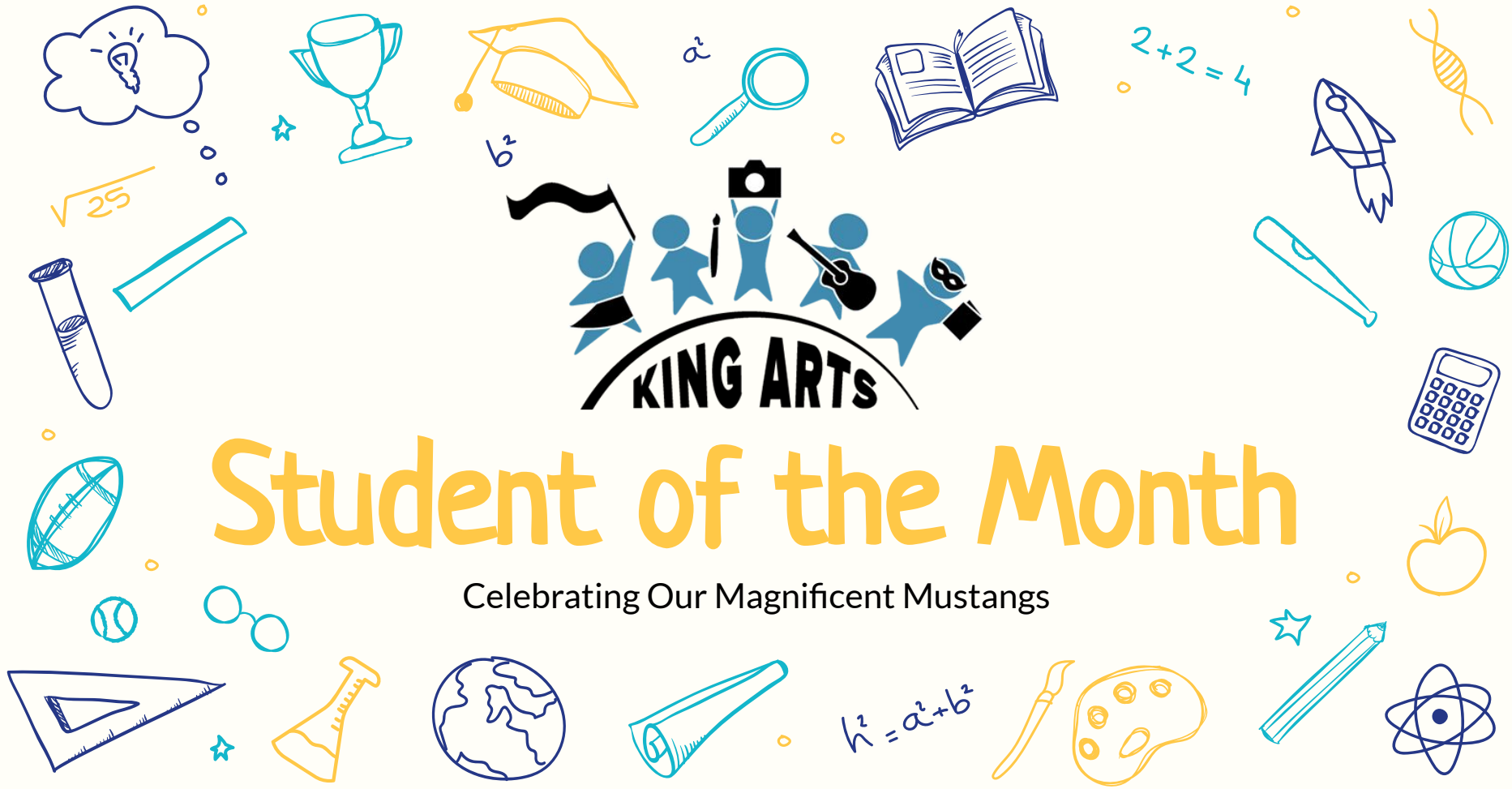

To acknowledge and celebrate the leaders we see here at King Arts, six students have been chosen this month to represent their grade band as **Student of the Month!**

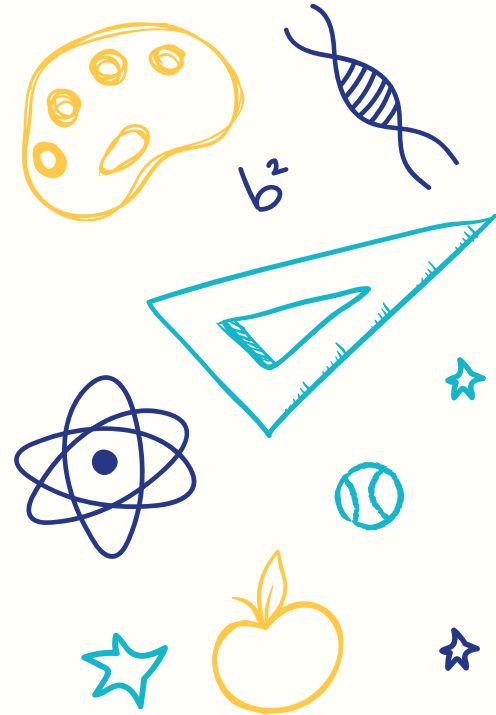




Selection Process

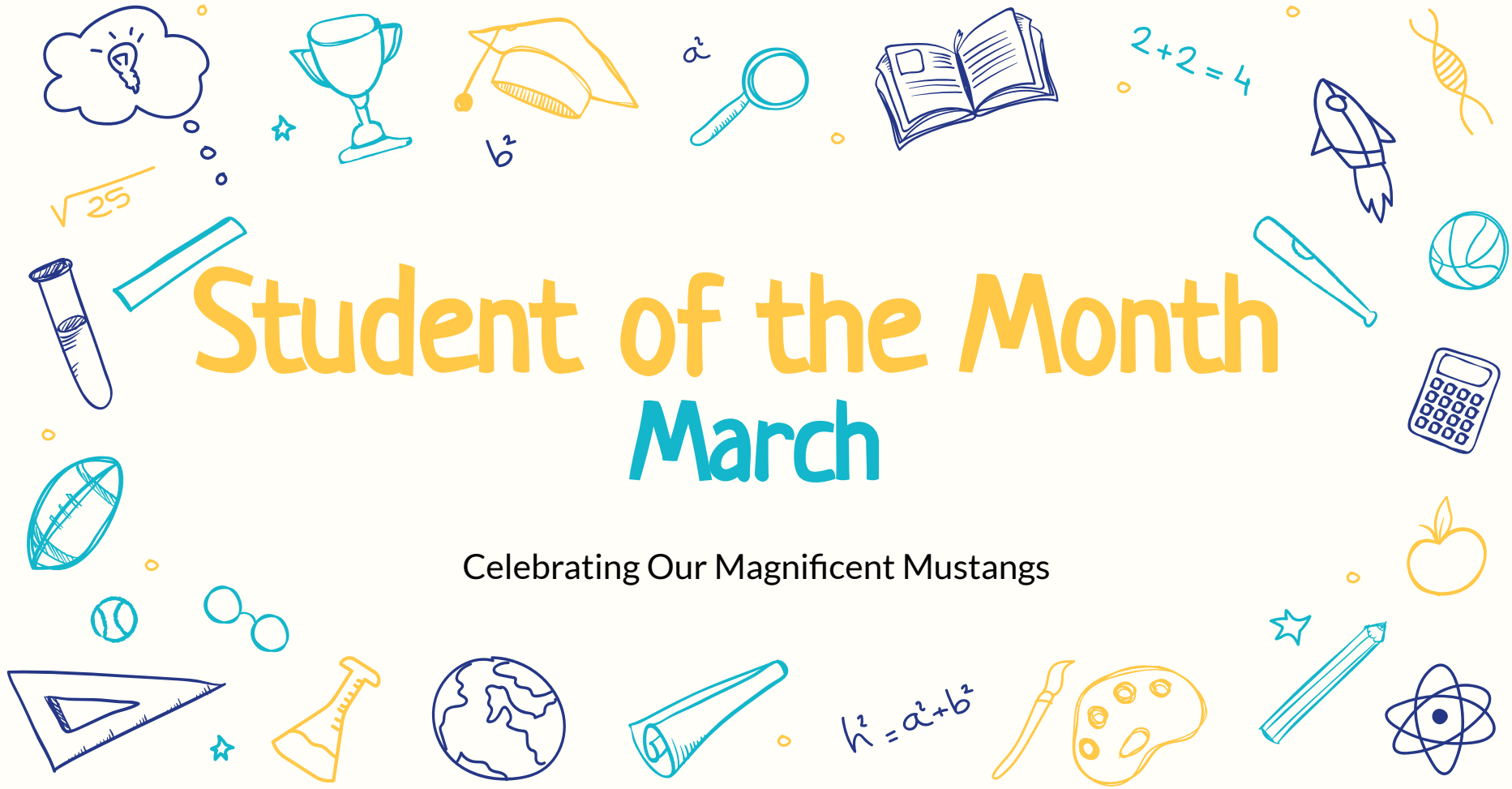
Each month a group of teachers are given the opportunity to select an outstanding student that demonstrates one or more aspects of our King Arts community guidelines- **The King High Five!**
