Compact Distribution & Communication Plan

To ensure the Family School Compact distribution process for new families or ones unable to attend conferences Lakeaires will follow the following procedures:

- **Communicate and have families sign up for Parent Teacher conferences in the fall**
- **Teachers will have on their conference agenda, time to review and share the Family School Compact**
- **Teachers will have parents sign in to verify attendance and receiving the information around Title 1 and the Compact**
- **Parents unable to attend the scheduled conference will be contacted by the classroom teacher to reschedule their child's conference where the Compact information will be shared**
- **Parents unable to attend scheduled conferences or make ups will be offered virtual conferences; the teacher will share the Compact information with the family either by sending a hard copy home in advance if time allows or by presenting it digitally to the family during a Google Meet conference call**
- **Families that still can not attend any of the options or do not respond will have the Compact Information available to them via the teacher's SeeSaw communication.**
