Signing In & Out

Students who are enrolled in Community School & Intramural Sports will be dismissed directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the class begins. The instructor will pick up your child from Kid Power and escort them to their designated area for their afterschool class. Once the class is over, please meet your child at the lower school front lobby doors for pick up. Students who do not get picked up after their class is over will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily after care rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's account.

Payment
