March 20 was a Professional Learning Day for Teachers

Teachers were provided flexible learning options and tools with a menu of activities from which to choose aligned to the school's academic goals.

Hair is a valuable tool for forensic scientists. It is more resistant to decay than most other body tissues and fluids, thus remaining intact far longer than other evidence.

This durability makes hair one of the most frequently found pieces of evidence at crime scenes.
