PSHE Health and Wellbeing

In this unit we will be identifying our strengths and thinking to the future to set goals.

Music- Musical history and notation

We will be playing music with a simple rhythm and pitch, exploring music from cultural dance and music from the 1960's.

French

We will be learning all things to do with the classroom. Using vocabulary for stationary, what is in our pencil cases and basic classroom commands.

Science – Living Things and Their Habitats

We will be sorting and categorise animals using classification keys, explore and use classification keys to groups identify and name living things in the local and wider environment. We will then look at changing environments and habitats that can pose a danger to living things.

Religious Education (R.E) Our Big Question

What does it mean to be a Buddhist in Britain today? We will be exploring what the religion looks like in Britain today and what does being a Buddhist involve.

Computing - We are Artists

Using the software Inkscape, we will create simple and complex tessellations and an artwork inspired by the artist Bridgit Riley. Using Scratch, we will be creating a repeating pattern and a pattern inspired by Islamic art.
