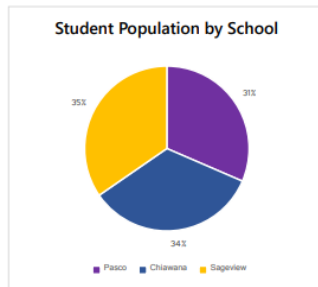

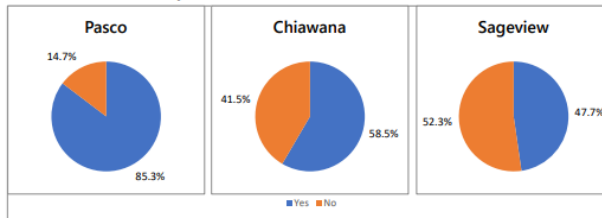
Scenario A: Student Distribution - Fall 2026



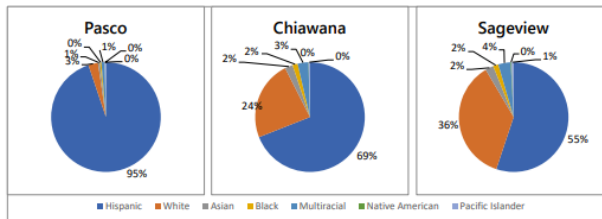

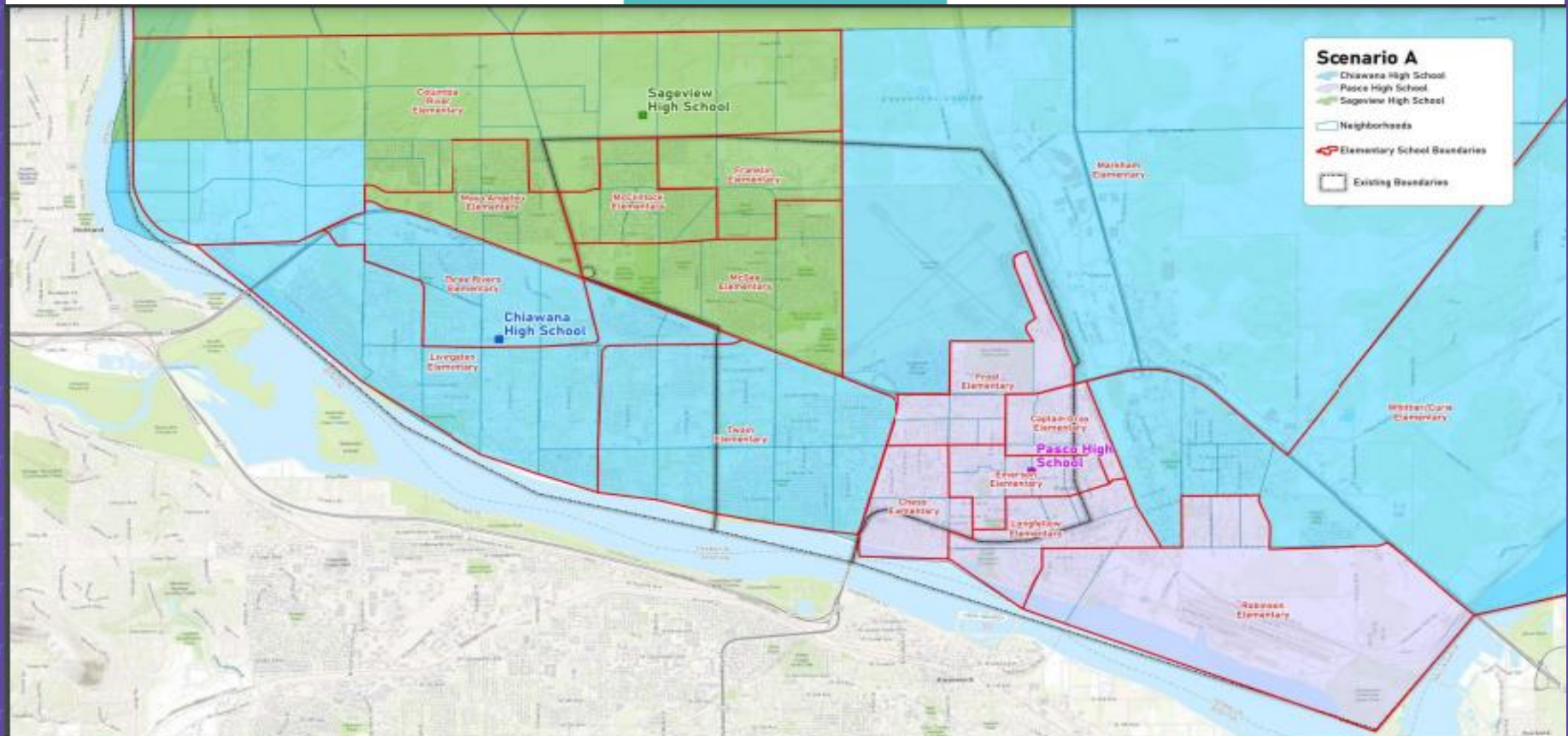

* Negative capacity over/under brick and mortar represents the number of students that would need to be in portable buildings.

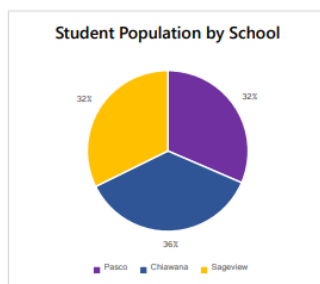

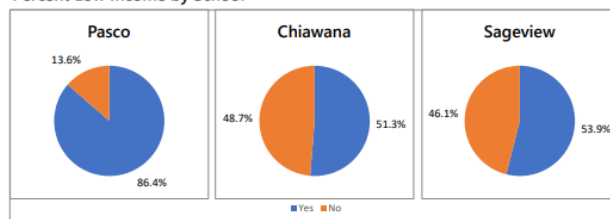
Scenario D: Student Distribution - Fall 2026



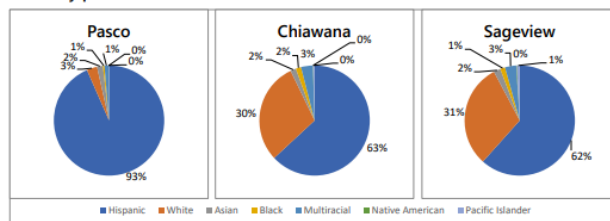

Ethnicity per School



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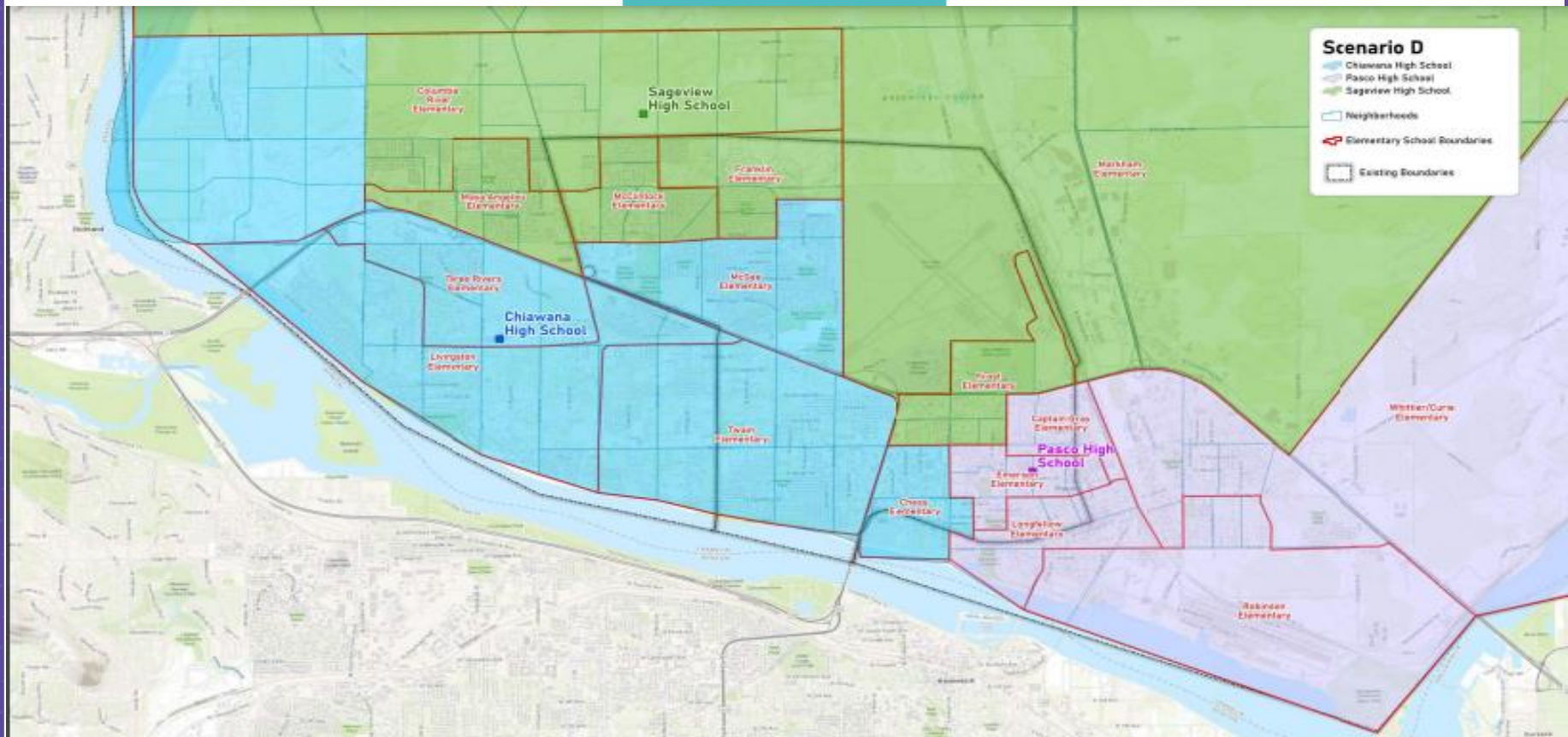
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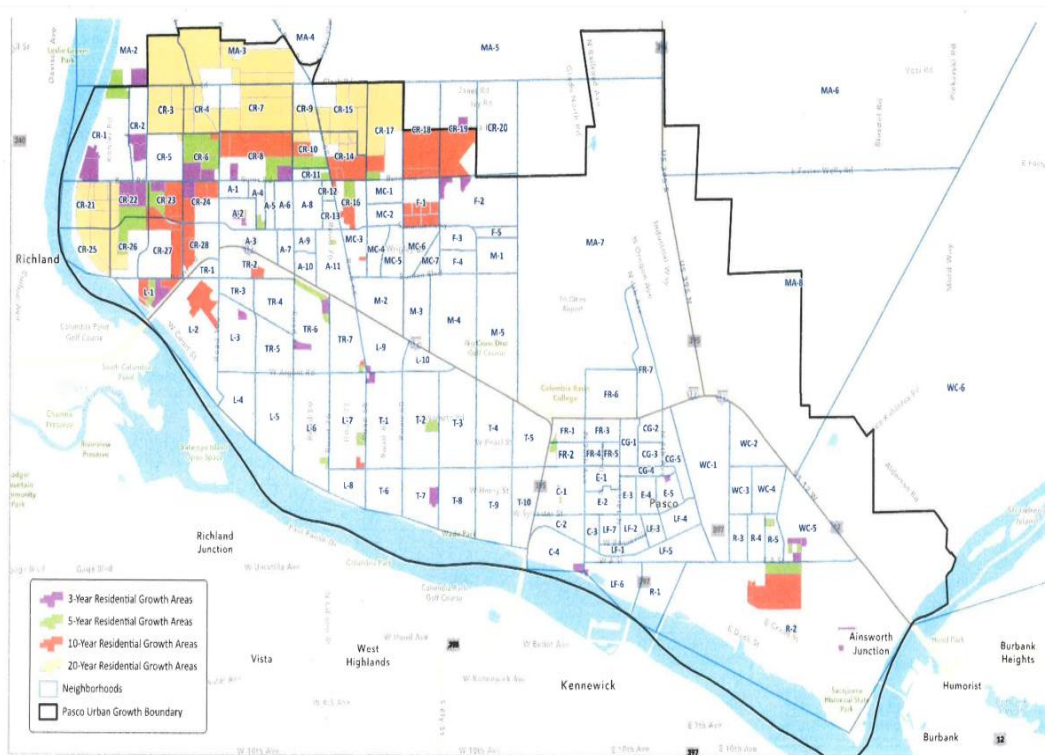
