Prepare to become an effective classroom teacher at the secondary level. Credits from this certificate can be applied toward a Master of Arts in Education/Secondary Teacher Education.

Graduate Initial Teacher Certificate/ Special Education (CERT/G-SPE)

Make a difference in the lives of students with learning disabilities. This certificate program teaches assessment of students with mild to moderate learning disabilities and how to instruct students with various behavioral and learning disorders. Licensure requirements vary by state. Depending on where you live and your chosen program, there are two pathways to achieve licensure: "Direct Apply" – states that accept our Arizona-approved program and permit candidates to apply directly for licensure, and "Reciprocity" – states that require candidates of our Arizona-approved program to obtain Arizona licensure first before applying for licensure in their home state.
