## 2024-2025 Middle School Elective Teacher

Community School of Naples, an independent, college preparatory school, is seeking a motivated and talented **full-time middle school Elective Teacher**.

### Description and Requirements

The 2024-25 teaching responsibilities will include developing and teaching elective courses, including an academic coaching elective for students needing assistance in the areas of organization, communication, reading, and writing. The other middle school electives will align with the candidate's education and experience. The current middle school elective courses fall into four categories: physical education electives; computer, technology, and innovation electives; fine and performing arts electives; and academic electives. The specific teaching assignment will depend on a candidate's background and abilities. This position requires **a bachelor's degree and at least 3 years of relevant teaching experience at the middle school level**.

This position will include a **teaching assignment of five classes a day** with an average class size of **fifteen students**. It also entails **advisory responsibilities** to approximately a dozen students a year and close, collaborative work with other advisors on a grade-level team. The grade-team works together to manage and attend the grade-specific program and student initiatives and issues throughout the school year. The ideal candidate would also be willing to mentor additional clubs. **Strong communication skills and the ability to inspire students to learn, engage, and create are essential**. The ideal candidate for this position is a person with wide-ranging interests who enjoys teaching and collaborating in an active, engaging middle school.
