RE: Mosaic for Dr. Brown

The CSA is requesting to dedicate a bench in the new Outdoor Classroom to Dr. Brown in honor of her retirement and all of her support in bringing this space to life. Rather than a stainless steel plaque, we are proposing something full of color and life to reflect Dr. Brown's personality. A mosaic plaque seems perfect and is in keeping with the mosaic legacy of the building. We are working with Julie Vitale who has reached out to [Carol Krentzman](#), a Natick-based mosaic/fused glass artist who has incredible works, including the [Court St Murals](#) downtown. While it won't work to put the plaque directly on the bench, we plan to put the 6' bench along the side of the shed and the plaque just above it. This way we can protect the mosaic from the elements better. See red box below for location.
