

2024 Senior Scholarship Information – Bulletin #1

Tod ‘Cleever’ Steese Memorial Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must be planning to attend an accredited two or four-year institution or trade school approved by the scholarship selection committee, applicant must also have participated in baseball, basketball, or football during their senior year

DEADLINE: **Due to Mrs. Dressler by 3/21/2024**

Keystone State Literacy Association-Susquehanna Valley

ELIGIBILITY: High school seniors who plan to attend college and major in education, must demonstrate a noteworthy academic record, and exhibit a sincere interest in literacy and education. Requires applicant to submit an essay.

DEADLINE: **Must be postmarked by 3/30/2024 and mailed to them.**

Community Giving Foundation Online Scholarships – to apply for any of the following scholarships students need to go to www.csgiving.org, click on “grants & scholarships”, click on “scholarships”, and then click on “scholarship site login.”

- **Joanne McCall Spaide Simington and Paul Simington Scholarship Fund**

ELIGIBILITY: Student must have resided in the Mifflinburg School District for a minimum of three years immediately prior to graduation and plan on attending an accredited two- or four-year college. The fund shall provide for students pursuing degrees in agriculture and/or forestry, but not including landscaping or landscape architecture, and/or education majors. Financial need will prevail over grades in awards selection.

DEADLINE: **All materials must be submitted online by 4/1/2024 prior to 11:59 p.m.**

- **Scholarship: Orlando C. Scopelliti Scholarship**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students entering degree programs for the care and/or education of the mentally and physical challenged. Students are eligible to apply upon acceptance to a qualified program for a bachelor’s, associate, or technical degree. This is a one-year award.

DEADLINE: **All materials must be submitted online by 4/1/2024 prior to 11:59 p.m**

- **Scholarship: The Dorothy St. John Gutelius Memorial Scholarship**

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is in memory of a previous long-term Mifflinburg Area educator who valued higher education and devoted her life to teaching. One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of MAHS. Preference is given to a student who displays a well-rounded approach and dedication to their education in the past and in the future.

DEADLINE: **All materials must be submitted online by 4/1/2024 prior to 11:59 p.m**

First Community Foundation Partnership of Pennsylvania Online Scholarships – to apply for any of the following scholarships students need to go to www.fcpartnership.org, click on “apply”, click on “scholarships”, and then click on “apply by district.” The “apply here” tab in the middle of the page will link you to the application.

- **T-Ross Brothers Construction Scholarship**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to a senior who is planning to attend an accredited college, university, vocational school, or trade school, and pursuing a degree in a construction related field. Must have maintained at least a B average. Preference will be given to a student who has background experience related to the construction industry and who intends to study construction technology with a concentration in carpentry, construction management. Secondary preference will be given to a student pursuing a degree in architectural engineering.

DEADLINE: **Applications must be submitted online by 4/1/2024**

- **Mary Jo and Donald L. Ritzenthaler Scholarship Fund**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students who plan to pursue a science or medical related degree including, but not limited to, pre-veterinary medicine, pre-medical, nursing or physician assistant programs. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing a degree in pre-veterinary medicine. Applicants must, also, demonstrate care of others (including animals) through volunteerism and financial need.

DEADLINE: **Applications must be submitted online by 4/1/2024**

- **Richard P. Lauchie Forestry Scholarship Fund**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students who plan to pursue a degree in a forest related field of study, including Forest Technology. Must demonstrate through an essay your appreciation for the forest and wood products industry.

DEADLINE: **Applications must be submitted online by 4/1/2024**

- **Kenneth and Marcia Johnson Scholarship Fund**

ELIGIBILITY: Open to students who have been accepted into a full-time accredited undergraduate degree program or accredited technical/trade school and have demonstrated financial need, applicants should be well rounded students and destined to well in their chosen field as demonstrated by their work ethic and/or participating in community and school activities, preference will be given to students pursuing a career in aviation, including but not limited to technical certification as an aircraft and power plant mechanic, an avionics technician, pilot training leading to advanced certifications, air traffic controller or aeronautical engineer

DEADLINE: **Applications must be submitted online by 4/1/2024**

- **First Community Foundation Partnership Regional Scholarship Fund**

ELIGIBILITY: Must be planning to attend college, university, or vocational school that offers a two-year or four-year degree or certification program. Applicants must complete an online application and answer an additional essay question that is determined by the FCFP Staff on a year-to-year basis.

DEADLINE: **Applications must be submitted online by 4/1/2024**

Scholarship: Mifflinburg Area Community Scholarship Trust, Inc.

ELIGIBILITY: MACST will be offering \$80,000 in scholarships to the seniors of the class of 2024. Applicants must be accepted to an accredited two/four-year institution or trade school. Applications are available on the school district's website – click on the “Community” tab and scroll down to “Mifflinburg Area Community Scholarship Trust Fund”. Scholarship applications can be found under the “Forms” section on the webpage. They, also, can be accessed via the Guidance Office Schoology Page.

DEADLINE: **Must be returned to the Guidance Office or mailed to them by 4/15/2024**

Scholarship: Mifflinburg Bank and Trust Scholarship Program

ELIGIBILITY: Seeking graduating seniors with a record of volunteerism in the community and in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.8, and plan to attend a 2- or 4-year accredited college for a business-related degree. Students will need to write an essay and obtain a Statement of Support and Letter of Recommendation from a Community Leader (not related to the school).

DEADLINE: **Must be mailed to them by 4/22/2024**
