

## 2024 Senior Scholarship Information – Bulletin #2

### **Jeff Koppel Memorial Head Start Scholarship Award**

Open to a graduating high school senior that is a former Head Start student and has been accepted (or pending acceptance) to an institution of higher learning (college/university; vocational/technical school). Selection criteria will be based upon academic and personal achievement, leadership and motivation, and extracurricular activities.

DEADLINE: **Must be submitted to them via email by 3/29/2024 by 4:00 p.m.**

### **John Family Health Careers Scholarship**

High school senior accepted to an accredited postsecondary school for the purpose of pursuing a degree for a career as a respiratory therapist, medical technologist, clinical laboratory scientist, cytotechnologist, or physical therapist. Preference will be given to children of veterans or active-duty military personnel. Students will need to complete an application, include a copy of their FAFSA, transcript, submit at least two written recommendations, and submit an essay.

DEADLINE: **Must be mailed to them by 4/1/2024**

### **Nursing Scholarships at Evangelical Community Hospital**

Candidates for the nursing scholarships are selected based on career goals at Evangelical Community Hospital, community service, financial need, and academic standing. Students will need to complete an application, include a copy of their FAFSA, transcript, submit at least two written recommendations, and submit an essay.

DEADLINE: **Must be mailed to them by 4/1/2024**

### **Nancy M. Neuman Citizenship Award**

Students who have demonstrated leadership potential through responsible and informed political action, advocacy, or service to the school or community. Students will need to write a shorty essay on why they believe they merit this award and on future plans in relation to the area of the award. A letter of recommendation is required as well.

DEADLINE: **Due to Miss Anderson in the Guidance Office by 4/23/2024**

### **Norman E. Buck Scholarship**

Seniors who plan to work in the professional fields of plumbing, heating, air conditioning, the culinary arts, hospitality, or music professions.

DEADLINE: **Must be submitted to the Guidance Office by 4/29/2024 or mailed directly to them by 5/6/2024**

**Citizens' Electric Award**

Senior accepted into a 2 or 4-year institution and enrolled in an engineering program. Must have an overall 3.0 GPA or better and write an essay.

DEADLINE: **Due in the Guidance Office by 4/23/2024**

**Mifflinburg Lodge 370 F & M - Scholarship**

ELIGIBILITY: For seniors who display service, scholarship, and are sponsored by one of our members (see Miss Anderson about this requirement). Must write an essay regarding your community service, provide a copy of your acceptance letter, submit a high school transcript, and a copy of your sponsor's dues cards.

DEADLINE: **Must be mailed to them by 4/22/2024**

**Dr. and Mrs. Harold Evans Scholarship**

This scholarship is offered to students entering pre-med, nursing, BSN, or Pharmacy.

DEADLINE: **Due in the guidance office by 4/25/2024**

**Pennsylvania Trappers Association District 7 Scholarship**

Open to a current high school senior who has attained a 2.0 cumulative grade point average (non-weighted) that is planning to continue their education beyond high school in an accredited institution of higher education or a technical school. Academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and an essay contest will be the basis of awarding the scholarship.

DEADLINE: **Must be received by them by 4/30/2024**

**Association for Inclusion, Respect, and Equity Scholarships**

- **Community Activist Scholarship** – This scholarship aims to support individuals who have demonstrated the desire, ability, and courage to contribute to a more inclusive future. Open to students who have demonstrated a commitment to advancing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion throughout their high school years.
- **Art, Design, and Music Scholarship** – This scholarship is intended for students who demonstrate a desire in creative writing, dance, drama, music, or visual arts. Open to students majoring in the arts in an undergraduate program.

DEADLINE: **Both scholarship applications are due to them by 6/1/2024**
