With the end of the Falls sports season upon us, it's safe to say that it has been another successful season for our MCI athletic teams. The Golf team recently competed at the Class C State Championship, where Owen Moore finished 2nd just one stroke behind the winner, followed by strong performances by the other MCI golfers. The Cross Country



team competed in the KVAC Championship meet this past weekend, where Addie Verrill (4th place) and Isaac Keresey (7th place) earned First Team All-Conference. Our Girls Soccer and Field Hockey teams enjoyed successful seasons that came to a close with their playoff appearances last week. The Boys Soccer team showed great promise and have a great future ahead of them, while our Football team is getting ready for their Quarterfinal game slated for tomorrow. The eSports team is just getting started and looking to capture another banner when their post-season emerges, and the MCI Cheering team enjoyed its first Fall season as a Varsity sport.
